Public lecture on mother language held

The Department of Law, East West University (EWU) organized a public lecture titled "Mayer Vashay Adalolter Ray" (Judgment of Courts in the Mother Language) on its campus at Aftabnagar in the capital on Saturday, says press release.

Bangladesh Supreme Court Justice Md Ashraful Kamal was the chief guest while Vice-Chancellor of the university Prof MM Shahidul Hassan chaired the programme.

Justice Md Ashraful Kamal also opined that the language of the court should not be complex and it must be comprehensible to general people. He expects that from this February, the month of the language movement, Bangla will be used as the language of the Supreme Court instead of English. In the programme, Chairperson of Department of Law, EWU Prof Dr Tureen Afroz delivered welcome address.
