## PM for wealthy people to set up public libraries

DHAKA, OCT 17: Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on Wednesday called upon the wealthy people to spend a part of their income for setting up public libraries in their respective, areas.

She made the plea while addressing the inaugural function of the National Conference of Library Professionals-2012 at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre in the city.

Hasina said that a section of people in the country nowadays earn quite a lot of money. "It won't be fair to spend all your money in travels abroad... spare some money for establishing public libraries in your villages, upazillas and districts."
