EWU Holds Its Second Convocation

The Second Convocation of East West University will be held on 20 May 2003 at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Conference Center, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka. His Excellency Professor Dr. lajuddin Ahmed, Hon'ble President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and Chancellor of East West University, has given his kind consent to be the chief guest of the occasion. The Hon ble President will participate in the convocation procession, address the gathering and confer degrees on the graduates. Dr. M. Osman Farruk MP, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, will attend the program as special guest. The Hon'ble Minister will also join the convocation procession and address the audience. Dr. Wahiduddin Mahmud, Professor of Economics, University of Dhaka and Advisor to the Caretaker Government 1996, will be the Convocation Speaker. ast West University hosted the fifth International Conference on Computer and Information Technology (ICCIT) 2002, the largest congregation of academicians and researchers in the field of ICT in the country, held on 27-28 December 2002. Dr. Mohammad Yunus, founder and Managing Director of Grameen Bank, opened the ICCIT at the Bangladesh China Conference Center on December 27, 2002. The opening session was presided by Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, founder Vice Chancellor and President of the Board of Directors, East West University, Among others UNIDO Regional Director for South Asia Mr. George B. Assaf, Dean of School of Engineering of the City College of the US City University of New York Mr. Muhammad A. Karim and ICCIT Chairman and Chair of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering of the host university Prof. Mozammel Hug Azad Khan and Registrar of EWU Mrs. Firdaus Ali spoke on the occasion.

Dr. Yunus in his speech maintained that no sector other than IT can play such a swift and decisive role in transforming the economy of Bangladesh in the 21st century. He also said that economic emancipation for countries like Bangladesh can only be possible if its huge population can be turned into human resources through carefully developed and executed plans in the areas of national priorities.

Dr. Farashuddin while addressing the gathering referred to the urgency of increasing scientific and technological contents in education without which doing away with poverty will remain a distant dream. He pleaded for greater collaboration among the policy-makers, academia and the industrialists in this regard.

The concluding session and dinner of the two day conference was held at Saffron Restaurant at Banani on 27 December 2002. Dr Abdul Moyeen Khan MP, Hon'ble Minister of Information and Communication Technology, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, attended the function as chief guest. Again President of EWU Board of Directors Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin chaired the session. In his speech Dr. Khan said that if proper facilities and environment can be ensured, more and more young people in the field of science and technology can play a significant role in the development of scientific research in Bangladesh. He revealed that his ministry would take all necessary steps to disseminate the knowledge of basic science among the students across the country. Crests were handed over to the technical session chairs of the conference on the occasion on behalf of the organizers.

Over 200 scientists, academics and researchers in the field of ICT both from home and 14 different countries took part in the conference and a total of 123 papers were presented in 21 working sessions during the two-day conference.

Seminar on **WTO** Rules on **RMG Held**

he Center for Research in Business, Economics and Technology (CERBET) of East West University and BGMEA Institute of Fashion and Technology jointly organized a seminar on 'WTO Rules and the Garments Industry in Bangladesh' on 5 January 2003 at Hotel Sonargaon, Hon'ble Minister of Commerce Mr. Amir Khasru Mahmud Chowdhury attended the occasion as chief guest. Mr. A.N.M. Ehasanul Hogue, Hon'ble State Minister of Education, was the special quest of the event and Mr. Kutubuddin Ahmed, former President of BGMEA presided over the session. Bangladesh Permanent Representative to the United Nations and WTO in Geneva Dr. Toufiq Ali presented the key-note paper at the seminar.

Hon'ble Minister of Commerce in his address stressed the need for capacity building by developing skilled workforce at all levels of production to help the country compete more vigorously in the global market with its exportable items. Mr. A.N. M. Ehsanul Hug while addressing the gathering referred to the current level of comparative advantage being enjoyed by Bangladesh and said that we should go for establishing composite textile industries to help

the RMG sector survive and sustain after 2004.

Dr. Toufig Ali in his key-note paper pointed out that the imposition of different rules and regulations by WTO would adversely affect Bangladesh in its trade in textiles. Even though these sectors in our country need to be particular about observing those rules and regulations to be effective from 2005 so as to avert exposition to actions by the imparting countries. Ambassador Ali also said that Bangladesh with its comparative advantages over the competing countries need to adapt with the changing demands of global market to remain more competitive.

The presentation was followed by a discussion session with Mr. Syed Manzur Elahi, Chaiman, Apex Group, former Advisor to the Caretaker Government and Treasurer of East West University, in the chair. Eminent leaders from the business community, representatives from the donor agencies, Excellencies, academics and senior government officials attended the seminar and also passed expert opinions and observations during the discussion session.

EWU Professor Wins UGC Award

Dr. Mohammed Ruhul Amin, Professor of Physics at East West University. won a research award in the field of Science and Technology. The University Grants Commission of Bangladesh bestowed the honor upon Professor Ruhul Amin for his important research work titling 'Low Frequency Electrostatic Waves in a Hot Magnetized Dusty Plasma'. Dr. M. Osman Farruk MP, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, gave away the award as chief guest to Professor Ruhul Amin at an UGC Award Giving Ceremony held on April 3, 2003 at LGED Bhaban, Agargaon, Dhaka.
