EWU's **Largest Ever**UNDERGRADUATE ORIENTATION CEREMONY


The orientation program for students admitted for Summer Semester 2006 in different undergraduate programs of East West University was held at the University Auditorium on May 20, 2006.

A former member of the erstwhile Civil Service of Pakistan of the 1961 batch, Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed is a former Secretary to the Government of Bangladesh and has a distinguished educational and service background. Mr. Ahmed had served in many important positions in the Government such as Chairman, Petrobangla, Joint Secretary-in-Charge, Prime Minster's Secretariat and Additional Secretary to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Bangladesh. He had also served as an ILO and UNFPA Regional Adviser on Population Education in Organized/Informal and NGO sectors for more than a decade.

Presently, Mr. Ahmed is also heading South-South Centre, Bangladesh, an NGO working in the field of Population, Health and Development.

The orientation program of the students who were admitted in Summer Semester 2006 to different graduate programs of East West University was held at the University Auditorium on May 18, 2006.

Mr. Golam Mainuddin, Deputy Managing Director, British American Tobacco Bangladesh, graced the graduate orientation program as the Chief Guest. EWU HOSTS INTER-UNIVERSITY PROGRAMMING CONTEST

"We believe, we have accomplished our goal of achieving insightful and collaborative cooperation and have proved that our young scientists can also become vital players in building a firm nation standing on the plank of concrete information and communication technology (ICT)," said Shahriar Manzoor, Judging Director for the panel of judges EWUIPC2006, who is also the only Bangladeshi chosen as a judge for the Association for Computing Machinery International Computer Programming Contest (ACMICPC).

The competition was participated by 75 teams of 34 private and public universities of the country. Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology xC33d team secured the first place, solving 7 problems out of 10 and three teams from East West University secured places within the declared 20 positions. East West University Golden Amalgum team secured the 7th position solving 5 problems out of 10; East West University Copotron held the 12th position solving 4 problems and East West University Freedom held the 19th position by solving 3. The first place winners each got an Apple Ipod and each member of the first runner-up, second runner-up and third runner-up team got iusb.

A seminar titled "New Growth of Software Industries: Getting Ready" was also held on the same day, which primarily focused on developing the existing links between the ICT industry and the nation's academia. Professor M A Mottalib, Chairman, Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, was the keynote speaker.

"While EWU stands as one of the well-established private universities of the country, such a competition has surely created considerable interest among the relatively younger universities to administer such practical ideas towards bringing out the budding apritude and capabilities from its apprentices," said Prof M Zafar Iqbal, Chief Judge, EWUIPC2006, urging more such competitions from the nation's universities towards demonstration of problem-solving ability, programming and team-skills.

The event was supported by EXIM Bank (Bangladesh), Citibank NA (Bangladesh) and Basis, while Computer Jagat, a prominent ICT monthly, acted as the official media partner for the contest. As part of its goal to promote academia co-curricular activities and bridge the gap between the academic world and industry, East West University Programming Club, with the collaboration of Department of Computer Science and Engineering, organized East West University Inter University Programming Contest (EWUIPC) 2006 on July 28th and 29th 2006. The closing ceremony was held at the university auditorium and was followed by a prize-giving episode designed to honor the winners of the competition.

Professor Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, President, Board of Directors and Founder Vice Chancellor, East West University was the session chair of the prize-giving ceremony. He congratulated the organizations for arranging this type of programming contest. He also thanked sponsors and media partners. He declared that "East West University will always contribute in this sort of process, which involves aptitude assessment of the students and thus accredit their talent".

"There was a time when we claimed knowledge is power, while nowadays it's more a question of information and data exchange capacity that replaces the earlier assertion, and hence more is required to develop exchanges between academics and the national ICT industry," said Dr, M Asaduzzaman, Chairman, University Grants Commission (UGC), noting how information technology has opened up huge opportunities for developing countries like Bangladesh.

Khandakar Rashed Maqsood, Vice President and Head, Global Transmission Services, welcomed such an initiative for bringing universities and industry together in a close, constructive collaboration to use such knowledge for mutual benefit and for the good of society. He congratulated all participating teams.

EWU LIBRARY

East West University (EWU) Library was established in 1996 and is now a rapidly growing organization unique among public and private universities of Bangladesh. To keep pace with the users' demand, its library system, accommodation, varieties of collections and service are developing gradually. The Library is the backbone of the research and development activities of East West University (EWU). The East West University Library's mission is to support the university community in developing lifelong skills in innovative and analytical thinking, research and information literacy by providing distinctive collections, services, facilities and programs. It is an integral part of the University and is designed to meet the information, research, and curriculum needs of its students, faculty, and staff members. The EWU Library is acquiring comprehensive collections to meet the needs of users. In the meantime, the University has developed six separate study rooms for six departments for facilitating a good study environment in the university. In course of time these study rooms will become seminar libraries for respective departments.





Library Accommodation

The Library can accommodate over 250 students at a time in its wellfurnished reading rooms. On an average 2,000 students visit the Library and 800 students take out or return books everyday. It has three floors for shelving reading materials and for accommodating readers in reading rooms as well as library personnel. Library pigeonholes are located on the ground floor of the foundation building and are to be used for keeping bags and other personal belongings.

Library Personnel

Professionally trained personnel are responsible for the care of EWU library and its contents, including the selection, processing, and organization of materials and delivery of information, instruction, and loan services to meet the needs of users. Library personnel are devoted to applying theory and technology for the creation, selection, organization, management, preservation, dissemination, and utilization of collections of information in all formats and to help manage and mediate access to information that may exist only in electronic form.

Library Automation

EWU Library is completely automated and uses its own library management software. The software's features include processing and issue/circulation based on barcodes and search as well as other useful features. The most exciting part of the automation is the web component. Students and faculty members use the web module for study and research purposes.
