Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin took charge of the President of the Board of Directors of East West University from 28 August for a period of two years. He has been elected president after the expiry of the term of Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed.

Dr. Farashuddin obtained his Ph.D. degree from Boston University, USA in the field of Cost-Benefit Analysis. Mohammed Farashuddin obtained an MA in Political Economy from Boston University as well as an MA in Economics and a BA (Honors) in Economics from the University of Dhaka with high distinction. Born in Habiganj in 1942, Mohammed Farashuddin has a very long working life spanning over 44 years of which 18 years has been in teaching Economics at the University of Dhaka and at East West University. Dr Farashuddin was also the founder President (BOD) and Vice-Chancellor of East University.

In 1966, Mohammed Farashuddin entered the Civil Service of Pakistan (CSP). Then followed a series of field-level administration cum development management assignments mostly in the field of administration during the period 1968-1972.

In the period 1972-75, Dr. Farashuddin worked in the Ministry of Finance and Planning and in the Prime Minister's Secretariat. During the period 1984-1995, Dr. Farashuddin worked in Iran, the Philippines and Maldives. On return to Bangladesh in 1995, Dr. Farashuddin initiated and led the establishment of East West University with a view to opening the door of a high quality modern and scientific education for the students of the middle class families at reasonable costs. From 1998 to 2001, he worked as Governor of Bangladesh Bank. Currently, Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin is also holding the position of the Chairman of Bangladesh Unnayan Parishad and working as a visiting professor in the Department of Economics at East West University.

EEE Department's Students Visit the Nuclear Reactor of AERE

33 senior students of the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering, along with Dr. Md. Ishfaqur

Raza and Dr. Khairul Alam, visited the Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE) at Savar in Dhaka to gain a firsthand experience about the sole nuclear reactor of the country. The 3MW TRIGA Mark-II nuclear reactor was commissioned in 1986 and is used for training, research and isotope production.



Mr. Md. Ali Zulkarnain, Director, Reactor Operations and Maintenance Unit (ROMU) personally took the students around the research institute. The students were briefed on the history of AERE, its current operations, research activities, and basics of a nuclear reactor. The students were taken into the reactor in small groups and were shown the reactor tank, the control rods, and other parts of the reactor unit.

The visit lasted for about 3 hours. Before departure, the faculty members of EWU presented the director with some souvenirs of EWU and the latest EWU research abstract publication.

He presented current state of open source software use in Bangladesh and in the world. Mr. Hoq considers open source software as a great gift for developing countries like Bangladesh. EWU Library

Today's world is preoccupied with exploration of information technology. Documents are now preserved on CD-Roms, WWW, or in any other digitized forms. Documents preserving, inventorying, management, learning is easier than ever before. Digital Library, Virtual Library, Library Automation these are very common terms in the present world. EWU Library is not lagging far behind these concepts and applications.

EWU Library preserves library resources through electronic means for the basic requirement of academic activities and research purposes. Printed resources are books, dissertation reports, thesis, print journals, and maps. EWU Library classified its books in various ways like text books, reference books, reserve or confined books.



Reference Books: EWU Library has an updated and latest edition of pure reference books such as Banglapedia, British Pharmacopeia's, US Pharmacopieas, Encyclopedia of Britanica, World Almanic, Encyclopedia of world religion, World Fact books, World Record Books, Encyclopedia of Strategic Management, Collection of Liberal wars of Bangladesh, Bangladesh Yellow pages, Collings Cobald English Dictionary, Oxford English Dictionary, Dictionary of Pharmacy, Dictionary of Marketing, Dictionary of Economics, Banglada Academy Dictionaries, TOEFL, GRE, SAT, and so forth. These most useful books are reference works and are not usually issued. But EWU Library users are highly encouraged to partially photocopy them for academic purposes. The reference section is located on the fourth floor of the foundation building.

Text Books: Text books are the prime resource of every course. We make things easier for the students by providing multidimensional

textbooks for students mentioning the "Text" in spine. So EWU Library has sufficient number of textbooks to its users of all courses. Text books are available at Circulation Section and Reserve Section.



Maps: EWU Library subscribes to high quality rare maps. Titles of the Maps are Administrative Divisions of Bangladesh, Maps of British India, Bengal province of the then India, World Map etc. These maps help tremendously in classroom presentation and interaction between faculty members and students.

Print Journals: Print journals are still a great source for researches. EWU subscribes to more than one hundred and forty foreign and local journals and periodicals. Among them: Harvard Business Review, Far Eastern Economic Review, Business World, Business Week, Newsweek, Fortune, Reader's Digest, JHPN, World Development Reports, World Development Indicators, UNACTAD Report, DU Journal of Microbiology, South Asian Journal of Management, Almost All publications of Bangladesh Bank, Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics and Ministry of Finance, DU Journal of Business administration, Jamini, BIIS papers, BIIS Journal, Trade Statistics, American Journal of Islamic Social Science, and so on.

CD-ROMs: Text Materials, Video Clippings, any pictorial format with sound effect are now preserved on CD-ROMs. EWU Library has more than 1200 CD-ROMs for its growing users. 



Seminars and Workshops

Dr. Samir Iqbal, Assistant Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering, University of Texas at Arlington, USA presented a talk on "Engineering Nanotechnology and MEMS for Smart Sensors" on 25 May, 2010 at East West University. The talk was jointly organized by the EEE Department, East West University and IEEE Electron Devices Society, Bangladesh Chapter. Students and faculty members of the EEE Department attended the talk. In this tutorial-like interactive presentation, Dr. Iqbal introduced MEMS to the students and discussed its possible use in sensors for medical applications.

Dr. Sayeef Salahuddin, Assistant Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, University of California, Berkeley gave a talk on the "Possibility of Negative Capacitance for Ultra Low Power Electronics" at East West University on 29 June 2010. This seminar was also jointly organized by the EEE Department, East West University and IEEE Electron Devices Society, Bangladesh Chapter. Students and faculty members from East West University as well as from other academic institutions including BUET, UIU, AUST and AIUB attended the seminar. Dr. Salahuddin is the inventor of negative capacitance MOSFET. This invention has been regarded as a major breakthrough in realizing low power electronics in the industry.

Prof. M. Nasir Uddin from University of LakeHead, Canada presented a talk on "Speed Control of Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motors Using Fuzzy Logic" at East West University on 8 August 2010. The seminar was attended by

more than 50 students from the engineering departments. The students very much appreciated the presentation which showed a real application of control of drives using novel approach for practical use in the industry.

EEE Department of East West University and the IEEE Student Branch of East West University jointly organized a day-long IEEE Teacher In-Service Program (TISP) workshop on 6 August 2010. This is the first time that this kind of workshop has been held in Bangladesh. The workshop enlightened the pre-university educators about the applications of science in engineering. This workshop is expected to enable the teachers to bring the ideas to the class rooms and motivate the students towards engineering education. IEEE, the largest professional organization in the world, has launched the TISP workshop worldwide to promote engineering education. Twenty one teachers from different schools of Dhaka, Kushtia, Jhenaidah, and Rajshahi participated in the workshop. The resource person of the workshop, representing IEEE, was Dr. Anis S. Haque, from the University of Calgary, Canada. The program started with a welcome speech by Professor Anisul Haque, chairperson, EEE department, EWU. After the welcome speech, Professor Harun Ur Rashid, Chair IEEE Bangladesh Section introduced IEEE to the participants. The workshop was concluded with distribution of certificates to the participants by Professor Ruhul Amin, Dean, Faculty of Sciences and Engineering, East West University.

Study Tour

33 senior students of the department of EEE, along with Associate professors Dr. Md. Ishfagur Raza and Dr. Khairul Alam, visited the Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE) in Savar to gain a firsthand experience about the sole nuclear reactor in the country. The 3MW TRIGA Mark-II nuclear reactor was commissioned in 1986 and is used for training, research and isotope production. Mr Md Ali Zulkarnain, Director, Reactor Operations and Maintenance Unit (ROMU) personally took the students around the research institute. The students were briefed on the history of AERE, its current operations, research activities, and basics of a nuclear reactor. The students were taken into the reactor in small groups and were shown the reactor tank, the control rods, and other parts of the reactor unit. The visit lasted for about 3 hours. Before departure, the faculty members of EWU presented the director with souvenirs of EWU and the latest EWU research abstract publication.

Visiting Professor from USA Teaches in the EEE Department

Dr. Abdul Malek Miah, Professor, Department of Industrial & Electrical Engineering Technology, South Carolina State University, USA joined the EEE Department, East West University in the Summer 2010 semester as a visiting faculty. A Fieldtrip to Lal Teer Seed Limited of Multimode Group

The MBA club of East West University organized a fieldtrip to the Lal Teer Seed Limited – a business venture of Multimode Group on 19 June 2010 at Gazipur. A number of MBA, EMBA & MBM students, MBA club members attended the trip. Mr. Abu Sadat Muhammad Ashif, Lecturer, Department of Business Administration, accompanied the students.



Lal Teer Seed Limited is basically a farm to produce hybrid seeds for the local farmers. This fieldtrip was organized with a view to attaining practical knowledge on operational management. The participants visited a modern biotechnology-based seed farm. Ten years ago, the farm was established in collaboration with the Netherlands. Initially, the farm had four foreign scientists and four Bangladeshi scientists. Now, the farm has four scientists having PhD degrees, 22 research scientists and 71 agriculturists working in different sections of the company.

On reaching the factory at 11:30 a.m., the General Manager, Operations, welcomed the students and delivered a speech to the students and guests. After that a scientist who is also the Departmental Head of the Research and Development Section gave a presentation on the entire process and production of the farm. The main aim of the company is to focus on high-yielding hybrid-crops that have disease-resistant characteristics. The farm has some specific commitments and

objectives such as (1) Quality seed supply (2) Minimizing imports and maximizing export of seed (3) Increase of vegetables production (4) Increase of nutrition supply.



All the participants observed the seed-breeding procedures and its applications in the standing plants and crops. Students enjoyed the delicious lunch provided by the company. Mr. Abu Sadat Muhammad Ashif, Lecturer, Department of Business Administration, presented crests to the officials of the company. He also thanked the Lal Teer Seed officials for their whole-hearted cooperation and support on behalf of EWU.



EWUBC has organized a study tour of REPTILES FARM LTD, Bhaluka, Maymensingh on July 31, 2010. A Total of 40 students went there along with the club moderator Mr. Mahmud Zubayer and Md. Sayed Alam.
