# RESEARCH GRANTS

Associate Professor and Chairperson Dr. Suraia Nusrin and Assistant Professor, Dr. Murshida Mahbub, have received a research grant of 3.5 lac BDT under special allocations (Interdisciplinary group) from the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST), Bangladesh in the financial year 2023-2024. The title of the project is "Analysis of the effects of food and water borne carcinogens on the cancer patients of Bangladesh". This study is aimed to analyze different food items to potentially save lives and reduce treatment cost.

This research grant will yield valuable insights into the challenges faced by the workers in Bangladesh. The importance of the research lies in its potential to drive positive change, advocate for the rights and well-being of workers, and promote a more equitable and just society.

Dr. Muhammed Shahriar Haque, Professor, Department of English, East West University received fund from East West University Centre for Research and Training to conduct a research project titled "Teaching Myanmar Curriculum in the World's Largest Refugee Camp: A Critical Insight".

Mohammad Pizuar Hossain, Senior Lecturer, Department of Law was awarded a conference grant by the European Cooperation in Science and Technology (EU COST Actions) to cover his international expenses for the COST Final Conference at the University of Oslo in Norway in January 2024.

Mohammad Pizuar Hossain also received fund from East West University Centre for Research and Training to conduct a research project titled "Human Rights Abuses against the Rohingya in Myanmar: Exploring the Role of Transitional Justice". This study completed on January O9, 2O24 aimed to identify policy implications for Myanmar's development of human rights-based policy frameworks for the Rohingya population, with the cooperation of Bangladesh and the international community. It suggests promoting a holistic approach to address human rights violations, including the implementation of transitional justice measures for the Rohingya community living in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh.

This webinar featured five insightful presentations by distinguished speakers: Dr. William R. Pruitt from Austin Peay State University, USA; Dr. Kerri J. Malloy from San Jose State University, USA; Dr. Narelle Fletche from the University of Technology Sydney, Australia; Mr. Mohammad Pizuar Hossain from East West University, Bangladesh; and Dr. Hilly Moodrick-Even Khen from Ariel University, Israel.

Mohammad Pizuar Hossain spoke on the lack of transparency in political advertisements on Facebook during an interview with Sarwar Hossain Suman on Channel 24 on December 25, 2023.
