East West University donates over 33L to chief adviser's relief fund for flood victims

In response to the severe flooding that has devastated the Feni, Comilla, and Noakhali districts, EWU has contributed over Tk3,371,000 to the chief adviser's Relief Fund.

This substantial donation was transferred to the chief adviser's Relief Funds account at Sonali Bank on Wednesday with the aim of providing immediate aid to those affected by the floods.

The generous donation was made possible by the collective efforts of the board of trustees, faculty members, and officials of East West University.
