At East West University, we not only scrupulously abide by the rules and regulations set by the relevant authority, but set our own norms and standards for achieving the excellence in education that we espouse. For one thing, we insist on a 30:1 teacher student ratio with at least eighty percent of teaching time done by full time faculty members. Also, in order to help blossom the merits of the children, there is, since the birth of East West University, a significant Merit Scholarship-cum-Need Based Financial Aid scheme. For the year 2005 alone, more than 800 students received such scholarships and financial aid amounting to taka two crore sixty lakhs. We make sure that teachers have decent office and education related facilities and students are in a congenial atmosphere with adequate class rooms, laboratory facilities, healthcare, sports facilities, library books, extra-curricular activity opportunities, free internet connections and other auxiliary services. Equally important, the university has a humane but strict, (zero tolerance) discipline policy. Obviously, the facilities shall vastly improve when East West University moves to its own campus at Rampura in about two years time.

And in fulfilling this crucial role, East West University has relentlessly pursued a policy of providing quality education since its foundation. We are happy that this uncompromising attitude of East West University towards quality and standard education has received social recognition and commendation. I emphasize our position in producing quality graduates here particularly because in recent times private universities have at times been the targets of social criticism on the question of quality and other academic and institutional grounds. On our part, we not only welcome social awareness and criticism but also ask for even more stringent institutional standards of quality control for the sake of higher education in the country. But as I have made clear on other occasions, while quality of education should be our prime concern, given the time, market forces themselves will also play a crucial role in quality maintenance in higher education.

How can I conclude my remarks without some advice for our fresh graduates! You are surely thinking about your career now. We believe that your academic knowledge, qualification, educational experience and personality training at East West University will help you throughout your career. Our best wishes are with you and we hope that you will excel in whatever professions you choose to be in. But do not restrict your thoughts, creative ideas and activities only to your own career and life; connect them to the society and its people. Despite the overwhelming spread and expansion of education in many societies since the World War II, education in our country, particularly good quality higher education, is still accessible to only particular classes of people. Considering this, you must feel yourself privileged to have attained quality higher education in the country. Therefore, you have social and moral obligations towards those who are less privileged; keep those obligations alive in your thoughts and actions and work out some feasible ways and means of changing the fate of our people. I feel very confident that the kind of you, the graduating class of today can make a major difference in institutionalizing democracy in Bangladesh and in taking the nation towards the light at the end of the tunnel we seemed to have embroiled ourselves in.
