East West University Telecommunications Club (EWUTC) is one of the most happening clubs of East West University started off their journey by a group of enthusiastic students in early 2008. Run by the student the primary objective of the club is to expose telecommunication related ideas among the students. EWUTC is rapidly making an impression within the University as one of its most active student run clubs. EWUTC was formed under supervision of department of Electronics and Communications Engineering of East West University. The Club's primary goal is to help the students to be acquainted with innovative ideas of telecommunications after they take academic lessons in classrooms. The club assists the students strongly to be practical that they learn from their books theoretically. So far the club has organized numerous workshops and seminars as a part of its regular practice for knowledge disseminating process and these were often conducted by eminent telecom experts of the industry. The Club has also taken students to field trips in the industry through which they have had a chance to see practical applications of whatever they learn in the classroom. In addition, the club never takes a step back in engaging its members in non-academic activities such as arranging picnics and excursions.

So far EWUTC has organized a vigorous number of workshops such as workshop on engineering software for fresher students, workshop on Packet Tracer, Linux, Mikrotic, Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS), and Radio Planning & Optimization etc. EWUTC has



arranged different seminars on contemporary views regarding both technological and economic aspects of telecommunications.

Telecommunications Club of East West University organized a workshop on "Advance Linux Networking via an ISP" on 27th October, 2008. The programme was held in the ICS lab equipped with adequate facilities.

One of the largest events of the club The Field Trip at the Submarine Cable Landing Station at Cox's Bazar, held on 27th-March, 2008. The journey started from the night of 25th-March and ended on the morning of 31 selected and qualified students of various disciplines like ICE, CSE and EEE got the opportunity to visit this fruitful trip. They got the real experience and practical knowledge on the submarine cable, its landing station and the equipments effectively.

In 2012, EWUTC stepped in the national level program for the students of universities and colleges, named "TELECO WARFARE". In its first episode "TELECO WARFARE 2012" on 13-14 September, EWUTC arranged four categories of competitions titled TELE WAR- Telecoms Quiz, NET WAR- Networking Contest, APPS WAR- Mobile Apps Making Contest and Q WAR- College Level Quiz. EWUTC was concerned to make a "TELECHAMP" through these friendly competitions. East West University has won the "TELECO WARFARE 2012" and titled as "TELECHAMP" having the points 201.05 out of 300.

Last year year they also organized TELECO WARFARE- 2013 on 25-27 September. The festival comprised of four different types of competitions- NET WAR, TELE WAR, APPS WAR and Q WAR. ■
