DR. FRRASHUDDIN ELECTED MEMBER OF UN INTERNATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION



The Chairperson of the Board of Trustees (BoT) of East West University (EWU) and former Bangladesh Bank Governor Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin has been elected Member of

the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC).

The ICSC is an independent expert body established by the United Nations General Assembly to regulate and coordinate the conditions of service of staff in the United Nations common system and promote high standards in the international civil service.

Dr. Farashuddin was unanimously elected as a representative Bangladesh to the ICSC, said the Bangladesh Permanent Mission to the UN.

Dr. Farashuddin and 14 others will serve for four-year terms on the commission. The committee is scheduled to begin work in January 2017.

The founding President (BoT) and Vice-Chancellor of East West University, Dr.Mohammed Farashuddin also served as the Personal Secretary to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman from 1973-1975.

He headed the Bangladesh Bank between 1998-2001. Dr. Farashuddin was born in Madhabpur in Habiganj. He started his career as a Lecturer of Economics Department after graduating from the University of Dhaka in 1964. He joined the Civil Service of the then Pakistan after that Later he completed Ph.D. from Boston University in the United States of America.

Dr. Farashuddin was also the member of the first Planning Commission in Bangladesh. He is married to Suraiya Farasuddin and they are blessed with a son and a daughter.

Vice Chancellor of East West University (EWU) Professor M. M. Shahidul Hassan has been honored with the Asia Education Leadership Award 2016. He was awarded with the International Society for Engineering Research and Development (ISERD) Excellent Paper Award for his paper 'Revamping Higher Education in Bangladesh'. He was also awarded with International Institute of Engineers and Researchers (IIER) Excellent Paper Presentation. The parer was presented at the 53rd ISERD International Conference in Zurich, Switzerland, on 30 – 31 October 2016.

Professor M. M. Shahidul Hassan has an outstanding record in teaching, research and consultancy. He is a gold medalist of Bangladesh Academy of Sciences, and was an Associate Member of Dr. Abdus Salam International Center for Theoretical Physics at Trieste. Italy. He served for the Bard of Accreditation for Engineering and Technological Education (BAETE) for ten years and is now a Board Member of BAETE. He is also the Vice President and Founder member. Educational Quality Assurance Foundation (EQAF). With a Doctorate in Electronic Engineering from Clarkson University, USA Dr. Hassan published extensively in the areas of Nano electronic devices, device modeling and simulation for Nano scale applications. He published fifty five papers in international and national journals and twenty six papers in international conferences. His present interest is in higher education and interactive teaching and learning. He published papers on education. particularly on outcome-based education (OBE). He received Bangladesh University Grants Commission Award in 2005, 2003, 1999 and 1991 for best research paper. Institute of Engineers, Bangladesh rendered him Special Honor in recognition of his excellence in engineering education.

One thousand current university students participated in a survey conducted by the Department of Law, Professor Dr. Tureen Afroz, Chairperson, Department of Law, EWU and the Prosecutor of the International Crimes Tribunal in Bangladesh highlighted the result of the survey in a research seminar held at EWU campus Aftabnagar, Dhaka on 20 November 2016.



93.6% of students (respondents) believe that the most crucial reason behind terrorism is family's apathy. 90.4% believes that political incitement and 89.1% believes that unemployment is responsible for terrorism. Besides, 84.6% of students believe that religious ignorance and 81.1% believes social media is the main reason for the proliferation of terrorism.

University students gave their opinion in the survey that appropriate education, family and social awareness, and monitoring can play an important role in preventing terrorism.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Chairperson of the Board of Trustees, EWU and former Governor of Bangladesh Bank was the Chair of the program. Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, Prime Minister's Media Adviser was the Chief Guest and Md. Monirul Islam, Additional Commissioner, Chief of Counter Terrorism Unit of Dhaka Metropolitan Police were Special Guests of the program. Professor Dr. M. M. Shahidul Hassan, Vice-Chancellor, EWU, addressed the welcome note.
