Nehreen Khan Memorial Speech by Prof. Serajul Islam Choudhury

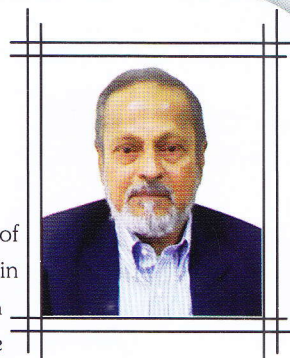


Emeritus Professor of Dhaka University Serajul Islam Choudhury believes that the ongoing social system is unjust and ailing. According to him, the powerful people or intellectuals of our society suppress their qualities like knowledge, intellect and kindheartedness, and they do so through the media. He expressed these views in the Nehreen Khan Memorial Speech program held on Wednesday afternoon, 12 July 2017. He said that the independence of our country has transformed power from foreigners to the local rulers, but the power structure remained the same. On the question of language, he said that at present English is more dominant than Bangla compared to the British era. In order to get rid of the evil cycle of our society, he suggested intellectuals should embrace knowledge, intellect and kindheartedness instead of self-interest.

This lecture was organized in the memory of Nehreen Khan former student of East West University, and late daughter of Dr. Akbar Ali Khan, Adviser to the Caretaker Government of Bangladesh. On this occasion, Professor Dr. Serajul Islam Choudhury was honored with a crest and a cheque amounting one lakh taka.

Professor Dr. M. M. Shahidul Hassan, Vice-Chancellor, EWU presided over the program. Dr. Akbar Ali Khan, Dr. Fakrul Alam, Professor of Dhaka University, A.Z.M. Shafiqul Alam, Treasurer of EWU, and late Nehreen Khan's classmates were also present at the program among other dignitaries.

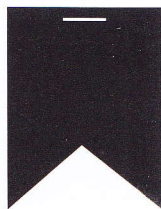
Obituary



Mr. M. A. Mumin, an established industrialist, social worker, and Founder Member of the Board of Trustees of East West University breathed his last at BIRDEM Hospital in Dhaka on 14 July 2017, Friday morning due to cardiac arrest (Inna Lillahe Wa Inna Illahi Rajiun). He died at the age of 76 years. He left behind his spouse, two sons, one daughter and a host of relatives and admirers. All members of East West University family expressed their deep condolences at his death and prayed to the Almighty for the salvation of the departed soul.

Mr. Mumin was elected a Vice Chairman of FBCCI in 1999. He was also a member of the Dhaka Stock Exchange (DSE). His first Namaz-e-Janaza was held on 14 July 2017, Saturday at 11:30 in the morning at East West University premises at Aftab Nagar, Dhaka and was attended by the Finance Minister Mr. Abul Mal Abdul Muhit, Member of the Board of Trustees, EWU, Mr. H. N. Ashequr Rahman M.P., Vice Chancellor of EWU Prof. M. M. Shahidul Hassan and others. Mr Mumin's second Namaz-e-Janaza was held on 15 July 2017, Saturday after asor prayer at Hazrat Sah Jalal (RA) Dargah in Sylhet. He was laid to rest at Hazrat Sah Jalal Dargah graveyard. East West University also organized a condolence program on 21 August 2017 followed by *doa mehfil* for late Mr. M. A. Mumin's departed soul. SAC of Electrical and Electronic Engineering Department organized a workshop on Course conduction and assessment in OBE for the faculty members of the department.

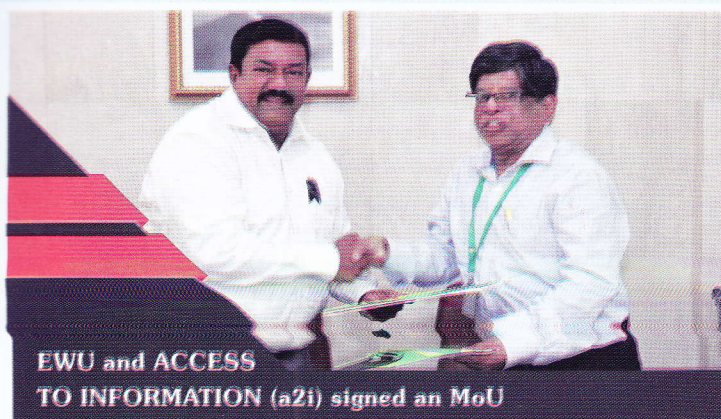

On the darker scenario, the passing away of Mr. M.A. Mumin, Founder Member of the Board of Trustees shook all EWU family members with shock and grief. Professor Serajul Islam Choudhury of Dhaka University, English Department gave the

first Nehreen Khan Memorial Speech, organized in memory of the deceased former student of English Department of EWU. Late Nehreen Khan was daughter of Dr. Akbar Ali Khan, former Adviser to the Caretaker Government of Bangladesh. The university also observed the national mourning day on 15 August 2017 with due respect to the Father of the Nation, Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

The brighter side of the institution was developments like – EWU signed a MoU with Access to Information (a2i) Program of Prime Minister's Office. EWU Library has brought new services such as— online article request, subscribing print journals, instant reference by messaging service using WhatsApp, and online membership registration. The Centre for Research and Training carried out a number of seminars, workshops, published abstracts, and valuable reports on disaster, health and gender. The Department of Students' Welfare was also involved in an array of seminars, workshops, training and recruitments for students. The Career Counseling Centre (CCC) also had a satisfactory internship and job placement turnouts. The students' clubs as usual thrived in various activities in connection to social awareness. Some exemplary activities by the clubs were – distributing clothes for needy people by the Environmental and Social Club and poster presentation of the epidemic viral disease Chikungunia by the Pharmacy Club.

Amid the heat, humid and monsoon, the summer stints of EWU were pretty much appreciable. We can thus proudly rejoice our achievements!

Training Programs

Soft Skills and Technical Skills training

Ernst & Young and Bangladesh Computer Council have been facilitating two training programs since 2015 in association with Career Counseling Center of EWU. The trainings are titled Top-Up IT & ITES Foundation skills; which are fully funded by the Government and supported by the World Bank.

Top-up IT training, a 300-hours module is for IT/Engineering students, and ITES (Information Technology Enabled Services) is for non-engineering students, is a 160-hours module consisting of soft skills and technical skills. Students are provided certificates along with a high employability opportunity linkage in the Bangladesh ICT industry. A total number of 155 students of Top-Up IT and 94 students of ITES training have successfully completed till mid of August 2017.

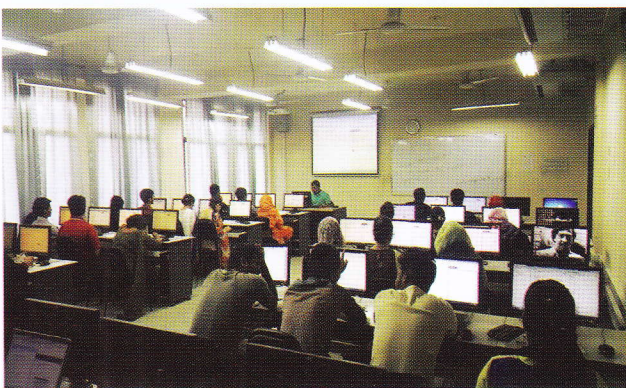

Analytics Qualifiers 2017

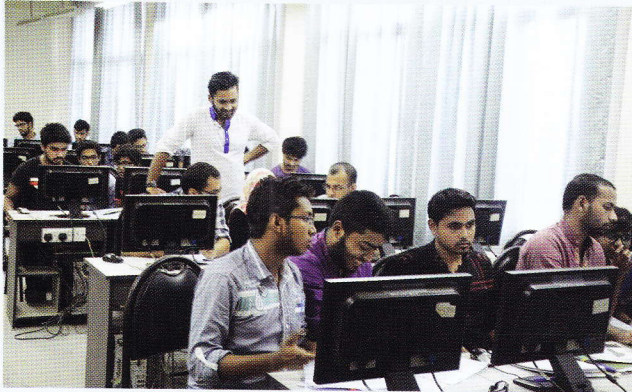

An event— Summer Celebration took place on 6 August 2017. T-shirts with the club logo were printed, a cultural event and lots of other activities were also arranged.



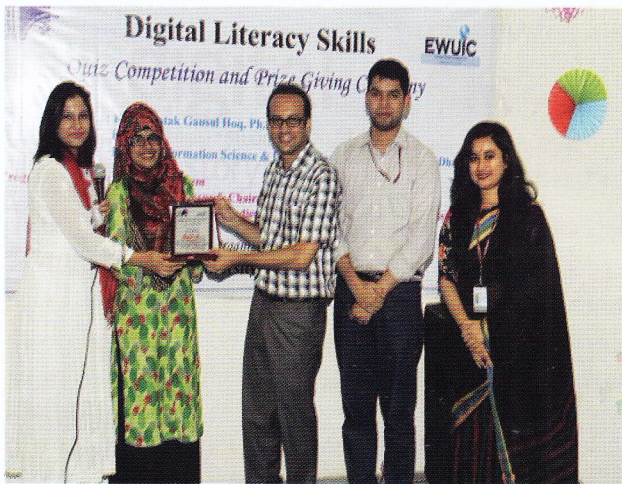

EWU PC arranged a new member recruitment from 21-23 May 2017 for the first time. 275 students joined program.



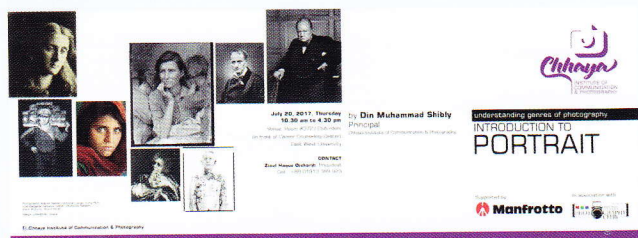

Science Club

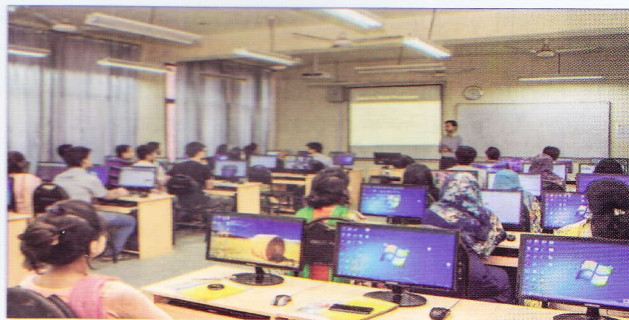
Workshop on AutoCAD
