Merit Scholarship Awarding Ceremony at EWU

East West University has awarded a total of Taka 1 Crore 60 Lakh to its meritorious students for the year 2004. This was disclosed by Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Vice Chancellor (Designate), and President, Board of Directors, East West University, at a Merit Scholarship Awarding Ceremony organized at EWU Auditorium on June 10, 2004.

Professor Dr. M. Asaduzzaman, Chairman, University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC) was present at the ceremony as the Chief Guest and distributed certificates among the merit scholarship earners for Summer Semester 2004. Professor Dr. Mahfuzul Huq, Member, UGC, also attended the program as the Special Guest. A total of 34 students received scholarship certificates for outstanding academic performance at the Merit Scholarship Awarding Ceremony.

In his speech Dr. M. Asaduzzaman congratulated students for their achievements and commended 'East West University as a very good university and excellent center for learning'. He also lauded EWU's scholarship schemes and said that the university has been doing an exemplary job in this regard.

Professor Dr. Mahfuzul Huq observed that EWU has already proved its worth in imparting quality education and is esteemed very highly among the private universities of the country. Professor Asaduzzaman and Professor Mahfuzul Huq expressed their hope that private universities will play a vital role in creating skilled human resources in the country.

Professor Haque Attends the South Asian Environment Economics Course for University Teachers

Professor A.K. Enamul Haque attended the SANDEE Research and Training Workshop in Sri Lanka from June 17-June 26, 2004. In the workshop Dr. Haque gave lectures on 'Measuring Benefits from Eco-Tourism', Benefits of Environmental Quality Improvement', 'Evaluating Productivity Changes due to Environmental Degradation' and 'Economics of Fisheries'. SANDEE runs this 3week training course on Environmental Economics for university teachers who lecture on Environmental Economics in India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Bhutan and Nepal. Dr. Haque is a regular faculty member in this training course. Other faculty members include Professor Sir Partha Das Gupta (University of Cambridge), Professor Karl Malor (Beijer Institute, Sweden), Professor Maurine Cropper (University of Maryland), Professor Rabindranath Bhattacharva (Kalvani University). Professor M.N. Murty (Institute of Economic Growth, Delhi) and Priya Shyamsundar of the World Bank. 23 university teachers from the region including 5 from Bangladesh attended the course.

Research Work Undertaken by Department of Pharmacy

In June 2004, the Department of Pharmacy, East West University started a collaborative research project with the Department of Biochemistry and Environmental Science of Louisiana State University, USA, on 'The Impact of Lead and Copper in Surface Water and Soil in Dhaka City'. In his address Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin said that East West University always provides full tuition waiver scholarships to its meritorious students. It also provides a large number of needbased scholarships among its students. Last year, the university awarded an amount of One Crore and Ten Lakh Taka, which is 6.75 per cent of its annual revenue, to a total of 366 students (14% of the students enrolled). This amount was

awarded as Merit Scholarship, Financial Aid and Tuition Waiver. This year, the university will also award an amount of Taka One Crore and Sixty Lakh as Merit Scholarships, Financial Aid and Tuition Waiver among 600 students.

Mrs. Firdaus Ali, Registrar, EWU also spoke on the occasion. The program was attended among others by the recipients of merit scholarships, their parents, and members of the faculty.

Seminar on ICT Job Market Trends & Future Directions at EWU

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering and the Computer Club of East West University jointly organized a seminar on 'ICT Job Market Trends and Future Direction' on June 22, 2004. The keynote paper was presented by the Chief Guest of the program Mr. A.K.M. Fahim Mashroor, CEO, BDJobs.com Ltd. The welcoming speech was delivered by Mr. Zakir Hossain Sarker, Senior Lecturer, Department of CSE and Moderator, Computer Club, While speaking on the occasion, Associate Professor and Chair of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Mr. Syed Akhter Hossain encouraged students and participants to keep up with the latest developments in the field and to enhance their skill sets in the fast-changing ICT field. The Special Guest of the program, Professor Mohammad Musa, Pro Vice Chancellor (Designate) of East West University, encouraged industry participation in developing market-driven skill sets in his speech.

Mr. A.K.M. Fahim Mashroor depicted the interesting scenario of the present ICT job sector of Bangladesh in his speech. He highlighted the major segments of the ICT job market and presented percentage distribution of ICT jobs along with skill sets till June 20, 2004. In addition, statistics of job vacancies announced were also presented. He also pointed out that potential employers were often not finding the right people. He also noted that while universities and colleges were producing graduates, in most cases market- driven skill were lacking in them. He pointed out that project management skills were wanting even though most IT service sectors are looking for good QA Managers, Business Analysts and Software Testers. He concluded with some tips on how to make a successful IT career.

The presentation was followed by a lively question-answer session. Among others, faculty members of various departments of the university, a large number of students and members of the East West University Computer Club attended the program.

Training program on SPSS Held

East West University hosted a two-day long training program at its computer Lab-5 on 'Meaning from Data Using SPSS' on July 08-09, 2004. Fullbright scholar Dr. Syed Saad Andaleeb, Chair and Professor, Department of Marketing, Pennsylvania State University, Erie, USA, conducted the training program. At that time Dr. Andaleeb was attached to CERBET, EWU.

The main purpose of the training program was to train researchers on how to use SPSS (Statistical Package for Social Science) for meaningful analysis of data. Seventeen participants, including young faculty members from private universities, and researchers from NGOs and Development Agencies attended the program.



Workshop on Software Requirements Engineering Held at EWU

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering and the Computer Club of East West University (EWU) jointly organized a workshop on Software Requirements Engineering Case Study on 20 July 2004. The workshop was conducted by Mr. T.I.M. Nurul Kabir, Vice President, BASIS. The welcome remarks on the occasion were delivered by Mr. Zakir Hossain Sarker, Senior Lecturer and Moderator. Computer Club. While speaking on the occasion Mr. Syed Akhter Hossain, Associate Professor and Chairperson, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, asked participants for real-life synthesis of software requirements and urged them to gain an understanding of the critical issues involved. The special guest of the program, Dr. Abu Saleh Abdun Noor, Chairperson, Department of Mathematics & Physics, focused in his speech on the innovations and revolutions in the ICT sector and encouraged the audience to develop deep understanding of the subject.

In his keynote address, the Chief Guest, Mr. T.I.M. Nurul Kabir, said that ICT graduates produced by the universities are semi-products. He said that most often software projects fail due to lack of understanding of requirements and stressed the need for involving the top management of the organization for the success of critical projects.

Participants, faculty members, and students asked a number of questions on related issues at the end of the program.

Poetry Festival at East West University

The Department of English of East West University (EWU) held a 'Poetry Festival' on July 19 at 5:00 p.m. at the EWU Auditorium, In all 23 performers, including



teachers as well as students of the department recited 20 popular poems on the occasion.

The program began with the Chairperson of the Department of English Professor Dr. Md. Shahidulla's reading of 'The Fire Sermon' from Section 3 of The Waste Land by T.S. Eliot. He discussed the theme of the poem before reading it out. The performers read out poems of English, American, Indian & Bangladeshi poets and English and Bangla translations of Latin American and European poets. Brief but useful introductions about the poets and poems read by the students were presented to make them more interesting. The teachers also gave brief introductions before reading out their chosen poems. The program was followed by a tea party.

EWU Hosts Seminar on Globalization and Institutional Development



East West University hosted a seminar on 'Globalization and Institutional Development' at the University Auditorium on Aug 04, 2004 at 5:00 p.m.

Dr. Roumeen Islam, Manager of the Poverty Reduction and Economic Management Unit of the World Bank Institute was the main speaker of the seminar. A select group of academics, policy planners, economists, industrialists, chamber leaders,

development partners, NGO managers and media representatives attended the seminar.

In her presentation, Dr. Roumeen Islam cited empirical evidence in support of her contention that economic integration is consistent with diversity in institutions. Dr. Islam noted that better institutions are necessary to enlarge choices; she even found that gains from international trade were not the monopoly of specialization alone as

diversification could also help such gains.

A lively discussion followed Dr. Roumeen Islam's erudite presentation at this well-attended seminar. Professor Rehman Sobhan, Professor Wahid Uddin Mahmud, Dr. Kazi Mesbauddin Ahmed (Member, Planning Commission), Mr. S. M. Al-Huseiny, (Former Member, Planning Commission), Syed Alamgir Faruq Chowdhury (Retired Commerce Secretary), Dr. Zaidi Satter (World Bank), Dr. Oazi Shahabuddin (Director General, BIDS), Dr. A. Hashem (formerly of ESCAP), Mr. G. Mortuza (General Manager, Research, Bangladesh Bank), Mr. H.N Ashegur Rahman (Member, Board of Directors, East West University) and Dr. Humaira Islam (Executive Director, Shakti Foundation) were amongst those who participated in the discussion.

Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Vice Chancellor (Designate), East West University, moderated the discussion and offered a vote of thanks.

Seminar

on IT in Media & Technology Held at EWU

Training Program for Research Team for BRAC Consulting Work

East West University organized a two-day long training program to train senior and mid-level field investigators of a research team for BRAC Pricing Policy Consultancy Work on 09-10 July 2004. Dr. M. Mazharul Islam, Professor, Department of Statistics, University of Dhaka, and Dr. Mohammad Musa, Professor of Finance & Pro Vice Chancellor (Designate), East West University were the resource persons of the training program.

The program focused on various aspects of research methodology. Contents of discussion in the sessions included:

- (a) sample design and selection of samples
- (b) implementation of questionnaire to collect data from sampled individuals
- (c) possible problems in data collection and
- (d) ways of sorting out problems in the field.

Setting New Standards for Undergraduate Studies at EWU

The Department of Economics has set new standards for undergraduate studies in Bangladesh. Under the new rules, a student in BSS in Economics can also complete a second major in any branch of Business Administration so that he or she can compete in the job market effectively. Similarly, a B. Pharm student at EWU will be among the first group of students who can simultaneously do a second major in any branches of Business (like Marketing, Finance, etc.). Similarly, BBA, B Pharm., B.Sc. Computer Science and Engineering students can earn a second major in Economics while completing their undergraduate studies at EWU.

The Department thinks that these changes in the curriculum will benefit all students of our undergraduate programs. With this step, EWU has pioneered a new academic setup for undergraduate studies in Bangladesh. Incidentally, these options are available at many universities abroad to promote crossbreeding of knowledge and to encourage multidisciplinary studies at undergraduate levels.

New Telecom Lab at the Dept. of Information & Communications Engineering

The Department of Information and Communications Engineering, East West University is setting up a new telecommunications lab. The purpose of the telecom lab is primarily to offer a hands-on experience to students on training and research by providing a practical demonstration and exercise field for the theory covered in the telecommunications courses offered by the university. The lab will also enable students to engage in a number of telecom projects, such as Analog Communications, Pulse Coded Modulation, Digital Communications, BER Calculation, Fiber Optics, CDMA, Transmit and Receiver Antenna, Microwave Engineering, etc. An important part of the Telecom Lab is the TIMS and MATLAB simulation tool made by TIMS Technologies. The lab will also be involved in the research of applications of computer networks such as wireless ad hoc sensor nets.
