

Commenting on EWU's current position as the number one private university in Bangladesh, Justice Amin praised the university's attempt to diffuse knowledge through promoting Eastern culture and values, and meaningfully blending them with Western thought and innovation. He pointed out that in Bangladesh private universities are designed to cater to students who want quality education in a cordial and politics-free environment.

He told the audience, "education, in general, is a continuous creative process, which aims at developing the intellectual capacity of an individual so that individuals can contribute to society." He added, "Bangladesh should be thankful for the initiative of private universities like East West University to complement the public sector in providing tertiary education to produce graduates who will be able to lead Bangladesh forward on the path of growth and prosperity in the years to come."

The Special Guest, Professor Nazrul Islam, also appreciated the University's generous merit scholarship

programme, and underscored its importance in exposing the richness and diversity of this country through its education, research and other activities. He noted that in a constantly changing world it is important to equip students with a global perspective to keep pace with the rest of the world.

The event was presided over by Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President of the Board of Directors of EWU. Mr. Ahmed recounted the achievements of East West University during the last ten years. He observed that the past decade was particularly a productive one for the university. It has made significant grounds in offering quality education to its students. Transmission of inequality from generation to generation, he noted, is a vicious circle, affecting our society. Only proper education is a great equalizer for us.

In his welcome speech, Vice Chancellor Professor Sharif reiterated the achievements of the University at the national and the regional level. He noted that they provided a befitting reason to celebrate the Foundation Day this year. He said "it is a day to pledge to work harder and attempt to reach higher." It may be mentioned here that in 1996, the University was established under the Private University Act, 1992, by the Progoti Foundation for Education and Development (PFED) with Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin as its first Vice Chancellor.

As a part of this programme, the chief guest handed over a cheque of Taka 50,000 on behalf of the University to Mrs. Rahima Asaszah, President of Assistance for Blind Children. The Environmental and Social Club of EWU also organized an art competition for children at 10.00 am on the same day and in the same venue to mark the anniversary. In the evening session, a cultural program, play and prize-giving ceremony also charmed the audience. Members of the Board of directors, faculty members, students and guests were present on this occasion.


Editorial

European Survey Finds East West, the Number One Private University in Bangladesh

East West University (EWU) has been ranked as the top private university and the third among public and private universities in the country. The EWU authorities formally announced this ranking at a press briefing at the university's administrative building at Mohakhali on 6 October 2007.

Professor Mohammed Sharif, Vice-Chancellor of East West University, conveyed this news in a press briefing in the presence Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President of Governing Board, Dr. Muhammed Farashuddin, Founder Vice-Chancellor and member of Governing Board, Rafiqul Huda Chowdhury, member of Governing Board and a good number of distinguished faculty members.



The Webometrics ranking of world universities was conducted by Cybermetrics Lab in July 2007 as a part of European Union funded project located in Spain. More than 11,000 universities of the world were considered in it. The ranking was based on research activities, international visibility, and volume of the scholarly documents created and published, and size and the impact of the web presence. Two public universities—Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) ranked first and Dhaka University ranked second among all the public and private universities in Bangladesh

In 1996 East West University was established under the Private University Act, 1992 by the Progoti Foundation for Education and Development (PFED) with Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin as its first Vice Chancellor. Dr. Mohammed Sharif, Professor Emeritus of the University of Rhode Island, USA, is the current Vice Chancellor of this university. Nearly 4,000 undergraduate and 950 graduate students are currently enrolled at EWU. EWU is committed to providing quality education for all.

EWU Research and Publications - a Leading Research Institution in Bangladesh

EWU faculty members are not only engaged in teaching, they are also contributing to research and publications both nationally and internationally. In 2006 alone, university faculty members have published and presented 50 research articles in international and local journals and conferences. Of these, only four were published in national journals while the rest were either published in international journals or presented in international conferences. Many EWU faculty members serve in program committees of reputed international conferences and in the panels of reviewers of a number of prestigious international journals. EWU faculty members are often quoted in our national media on various issues relating to the economy and development. To promote faculty research at EWU, the university has been publishing journals and annual abstracts, financing conference attendance at home and abroad, and also providing grants for research. This is unique to the culture of private universities in this country. The first volume of the EWU Journal, published in 2007, came out with 14 research articles.

In addition, two outstanding undergraduate students of EWU, S.H. Shah Newaz and Kazi Md Abdullah Al Mamun were invited to present their research findings at the International Conference on Convergence Information Technology (ICCIT07) in South Korea in November of this year. The proceedings of the conference will be published by IEEE, the largest international professional society of electrical, electronic and computer engineers based in the USA. It is relevant to note here that they are undergraduate students in Information and Communication Engineering.

EWU offers Free Tuition and Living Support for 6 GPA 5 Students (one from each Administrative Division)

EWU will offer full tuition waiver and living allowances to one deserving student with GPA 5 from each division of the country from spring 2008. It should be stressed that EWU also offers a number of scholarship and financial aid schemes to both meritorious and poor students. In 2006 alone, the university distributed Tk.3,29,00,000/- - more than 10% of its annual revenue - as merit scholarships and financial aid to 1239 students. EWU's Medha Lalon Fund developed with voluntary donations from philanthropic individuals and organizations, is a part of these schemes.

EWU Donation for Fire-victims

East West University has contributed a total of Taka 1.5 laks to the families of six fire-victims on 23 September.

In a simple ceremony, Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President, Board of the Directors of East West University, in the presence of Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, founder Vice Chancellor, and Professor Mohammed Sharif, Vice Chancellor of the University, handed over the cheque of Taka 25 thousand to a parent of each victim.

On 21st February, 2006, Mostofa, Lal Mia, Idris, Sohel, Monsur Ali and James Baroi lost their lives in a fire accident while cleansing a water reservoir at the basement of the Pacific Tower of which East West University is a tenant. The cleansing work had been undertaken by the owner of Pacific Tower Buildings. Since the incident occurred in an East West University campus building, the Board of Directors of the University decided on humanitarian ground to contribute Taka 25 thousand each to the families of the six fire-victims.



East West hosts ACM International Collegiate Programming Contest

East West University hosted the Dhaka Regional ACM International Collegiate Programming Contest (ICPC) 2007 on 8 December 2007 at Bangladesh China Friendship Conference Center (BCFCC).

The BUET Sprinter team came out first in this contest. Fudan University of China was placed second and the third place went to the East West University's "Dream of Twilight" team.

Justice Mohammad Habibur Rahman, former Chief Justice and Chief



Advisor of Caretaker Govt, of Bangladesh, graced the inaugural ceremony as the Chief Guest. In his speech, Justice Rahman stressed that we have to add a new chapter to education through computer. EWU Library

Introduction: EWU Library is playing a significant role as a supporting section of the whole educational process of East West University. Daily, about 2000 users visit EWU Library. Out of them, 300 to 500 users get circulation facilities, 100 to 200 users receive photocopy facilities, 200 to 300 users avail journals and newspapers facilities, while other readers use text books, reference books & reference services facilities. Moreover, a good number of users search online journals through our computer terminals.



EWU library is fully automated. Very flexible software, developed by the Software Development Centre (SDC), helps a lot in automating the Library system. To control and support a large number of users, EWU Library has several sections, namely; Circulation, Procurement, Journal and Reference, Processing, Online Resources, Photocopy Services, Reserve Books Services, Pigeon-Hole, New Arrivals Dissemination Services, and Library Administration. All the sections of the Library are working together as a team to support the whole university community. Different sections of the Library have been created for providing fruitful library services to the users' community.

EWU Library is located on 2nd, 3rd, and 4th floor of the Foundation Building of its premises. Besides, new arrivals display board and a pigeonhole area are located on the ground floor of the same building.

Circulation Section: The Circulation Section is located on the 3rd floor of the Foundation Building. It is a mirror of EWU Library. Lending and borrowing services, users' guidance, reference services, referral services, in-house telephonic response and any query regarding Library services are maintained by Circulation Section. A team consisting of some young and dynamic library professionals is working for the Circulation Section.

Procurement Section: This section is situated on the 2nd and 3rd floor of the Foundation Building. A good number of reading materials are added day by day to the existing collections to meet the requirements of the academic community. It also fulfills the University's research purpose. An efficient procurement team, consisting of two Assistant Librarians, is responsible for procurement in the Library. At present, the total number of books and CDs are 17,500 and 1,245 respectively in the Library.

Journal and Reference Section: Reference Section is located on the 4th floor of the Foundation Building. This section contains reference materials, namely, encyclopedias, dictionaries, daily newspapers, print journals, periodicals, magazines, maps, newsletters, research reports, and pure reference reading materials. Among them, print journals are very important for the users, particularly, those who carry out their research work in the Library. These journals are being used as primary source of information, which are very important for any researcher. At present, the EWU Library is subscribing, on a regular basis, to 140 titles of print journals/ periodicals /magazines for the University, Currently, the Library has sixteen daily newspapers, six maps, and two hundred internship reports with other reference materials. One Assistant Library Officer/Library Circulation Officer is entrusted to do this job.

Processing Section: Without processing, no book is readily available on the shelf of the Library. To find out the book very quickly, processing is very significant for any library. After receipt of library materials, there is number of jobs to be done in the library, such as, physical check up of books, sealing, cataloguing, classification, data entry, preparing book slips, book pockets, bar coding, pasting and finally shelving. EWU Library performs this job manually and automatically. One Assistant Librarian, assisted by two staff members, is responsible for processing.

Online Resource Section: EWU Library is confined not only to collect traditional books and journals. It is also one of the best online resource centers among private universities in Bangladesh. It subscribes world's leading online Journals; i.e., ISTOR (Journal Storage), IEEE (The Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, facilities available only for individual faculty members) and ACM (Association for Computing Machinery, facilities available only for individual faculty members). Besides, the Library is getting free access to HINARI (Health Inter Network Access to Research Initiative), AGORA (Access to Global Online Research in Agriculture), OUP (Oxford University Press), and Highwire Press (Stanford University's free online journals site) journals. All users can find many electronic journals and access full-text articles of the above-mentioned databases. To get the URL of the abovementioned databases, please contact the Library.



Consortium: East West University is subscribing to the 'Bangladesh INASP-PERI Consortium (BIPC)' http://www.inasp.info, http://peri.inasp.info/peri/peri.pl for getting access to full-text articles/abstracts/bibliographical information of online journals of different publishers of different disciplines through the Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS). Access to online journals is IP based. All users of EWU will be able to get access to these on-line journals from the LAN (local area network) of EWU.

Photocopy Services: The EWU Library has a Photocopy Corner located at the entrance on the 2nd floor of the Foundation Building. The Photocopy Corner is open from 8.30 am to 5.00 pm with half-an-hour (from 1.30pm to 2.00 pm) break for lunch. After 5.00 pm and on Fridays photocopy will be made available from Photocopy Centre of the University located at Research Building. The Library Photocopy Corner is closed on Fridays and Saturdays.

Pigeon-Hole Area: Pigeon-hole support services are available on the ground floor of the Foundation Building, where more than 400 students can keep their personal belongings at a time.



New Arrivals Display Area: One New Arrival display board is also located on the ground floor of the Foundation Building. All the users may find the book jackets or title pages of new books, which arrived recently, in the Library board.

Reserve Section: This section is very important for students, because a minimum of one copy of all titles is available here for study purpose. It is a spacious study room, where more than 120 students can sit at a time. The section is situated on the second floor of the Foundation Building. The Library's special corner is also located there.

Library Administration: Overall library administration is the responsibility of the Joint Librarian, East West University.

EWU Library Launched Web Based Service: From Fall semester 2007, EWU library has introduced web-based library services. Henceforth, users can search our library resources from home. Moreover, borrowing status, library books' status, online journal icon, and user's guide, are also available on the web. Users' are requested to search at http://www.ewubd.edu/of EWU Library.

Recent Training and Workshop Activities of Library Personnel: Mr. A. I. M. Jakaria Rahman, Assistant Librarian, and Mr. Nasir Uddin, Data Management Assistant, participated in a 3-day Training Course on Optimising the use of Electronic Resources available via PERI, held on 23-25 October 2007, at Sasakawa International Training Centre, ICDDR,B, Mohakhali, Dhaka. The course was organized and conducted by Bangladesh-INASP (International Network for the availability of Scientific Publications) - PERI (Programme for the Enhancement of Research Information) Consortium (BIPC) and Library and Information Service Unit (LISU), ICDDR,B and coordinated by Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS). 36 participants from 21 institutions from all over Bangladesh attended this course.

Mr. Md. Nazim Uddin, Joint librarian, Mr. A. I. M. Jakaria Rahman, Assistant Librarian and Mr. Nasir Uddin, Data Management Assistant, also participated in a seminar on "Scholarly Communication in the Digital Environment; Opportunities and Challenges for Researchers in Bangladesh" held on Thursday, 25 October 2007, at the Sasakawa International Training Centre of ICCDR,B, Mohakhali, Dhaka.

Mr. Md. Nazim Uddin, Joint Librarian, attended a Workshop on Refresher Training for National Health Library and Other Health Library Personnel on Library Science and its Skills, held on 18 December 2007, at National Health Library and Documentation Centre, Mohakhali, Dhaka. The second phase of the program consisted of a seminar. The aim of the seminar was to increase the knowledge among students about the impact of HIV/AIDS. Many students, including those who attended the rally, joined the seminar with great enthusiasm. The seminar was chaired by Dr. Mohammed Sharif, Vice Chancellor, EWU. In the concluding remarks, Dr. Sharif expressed his concern about the threats of HIV/AIDS and cautioned students to be aware of the causes and effects of this deadly disease. Finally, and before the seminar ended, Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed presented a crest to Dr. Hashina Begum. The seminar concluded with refreshments for the participants.




