7th Convocation of East West University

"Global warming is an alarming phenomenon for the entire world community"

President Dr. Iajuddin Ahmed

The seventh convocation of East West University was held on 3rd March at the Bangladesh-China Friendship Conference Center, Dhaka. A total of 604 undergraduate and 275 graduate students were conferred degrees. Two students were honored with gold medals for outstanding academic performance.

His Excellency, Professor Dr. Iajuddin Ahmed, President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and Chancellor of East West University, presided over the convocation. In his speech he urged public and private universities to give more attention to science and information technology (IT) as well as the conventional arts, social sciences and commerce

subjects so that students can cope with a fast-changing world.



The President noted that the emergence of a new economic order worldwide and the rapid development of IT have extended the horizons of higher education, particularly in the fields of market economy and IT. As he pointed out, "It is obvious that policymakers, institutions and the academia of the country need to gear themselves up to deal with the challenges posed by the new situation. It is time for all of those who are associated with the planning and implementation of educational programes to revitalize their thinking and focus on the subject (IT)." President Iajuddin also noted that the whole purpose of education in a developing country like Bangladesh is to develop and enhance human resources and progressively transform the country into a knowledge-based society.

Referring to the issue of global warming, President Ahmed called on all at home and abroad to maintain the ecological balance in order to build a safe and habitable abode for everyone. He observed that global warming is an alarming phenomenon for the entire world community, particularly for developing countries like Bangladesh. The Inter-Governmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) through its impact assessments has identified Bangladesh as one of the most 'susceptible countries' of the world.

The President went on to observe, "The IPCC projects that the impact of global warming will increase the sea level, atmospheric temperature and rainfall and will intensify natural disasters in the form of floods, cyclones, storm surges and drought." He called on graduates to keep accumulating knowledge, make the best use of their learning and pursue higher scholarship in ways that will enable them to serve the nation.



Delivering the convocation speech, former Chief Adviser of one of our caretaker governments, Justice Muhammad Habibur Rahman, observed that a university functions to locate and identify problems and suggest remedies for the maladies that are bedeviling society. Justice Rahman declared that a university is not a college. It is not even a congerie of colleges. It is something more than that. It is nothing if it does not foster free thinking, innovation and research. Justice Rahman criticized some private universities for creating a very sad mess. "The sad stories of sheer fraud and mismanagement that circulate about some of the private universities also reflect the callousness, narrow partisanship and thorough incompetence of the government's regulatory roles. Presently, however, some attempts are being made to stop some shameful and nefarious activities in this area," he said. Appreciating the role of East West



University, he asserted, "East West University is a bright exception to the unfortunate situation. It has already earned a good name. I hope thus it will not get embroiled in non-academic profiteering ventures."

Vice Chancellor of the university, Prof Mohammed Sharif, and President of Board of Directors, Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, also spoke on this occasion.

In his speech, Vice Chancellor Professor Mohammed Sharif observed, "After getting the approval from the government under the Private Universities Act of 1992, East West University began its voyage in 1996 with only six faculty members and twenty students. But in a comparatively short period it has achieved outstanding success. Today we may take pride in being one of the top universities of this country. No wonder there has been a tremendous increase in the number of students seeking admission to EWU," He told graduates that they should have great confidence in their future prospects. He pointed out that their seniors had already proven themselves in various

organizations and in the corporate world. In fact, the high employment rate of EWU graduates has surely been a vital factor influencing the competition for enrollment at EWU. Graduates from this university are already working with renowned organizations and the quality of its graduates are being appreciated everywhere in Bangladesh.

Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President of the Board of Directors of East West University, told students that this was their day, and they had earned the right to be proud of their accomplishments. But he reminded them that their achievements were not their alone. If they thought about it, they would realize that their success would not have been possible without their parents, teachers, and the staff of the university, and their friends and well-wishers.




EWU launches New Website

EWU celebrates "Pohela Boishakh"



EWU Library: Strengthening ICT Based Library Services

East West University library is one of the pioneering private university libraries of Bangladesh. It has successfully installed Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in all aspects of library services. It launched computer-based library services effectively in 1996. To keep pace with modern IT based world, EWU Library, in assistance with Software Development Center (SDC), developed a unique indigenous library software namely EWULIBMIS to support and manage various activities of the EWU Library. Web-based library service is its new feature to provide library facilities and services through internet. This web-based library services has opened a new horizon for users of EWU Library.

Objectives

- To support the University emerge as a leading university
 of the country, embracing traditional values of higher
 education but adapted to the global community of
 the 21st century.
- To identify, acquire, organise, store, and provide ondemandaccess to the available intellectual and research products of scholars to support teaching, learning, research and creative endeavors.
- To provide greater access to digital collections while continuing to build and improve access to collections in all formats to meet the research and teaching needs of the university.
- To foster information literacy and work involving the EWU community and to enable users to think critically, create knowledge, and be life-long learners.
- To provide and ensure quality services and good professional practice in Library activities. To serve students, teachers and other officials with state-of-art techniques and technologies.

Library Collection

EWU Library has a rapidly growing collection. At present the Library possesses 21,713 books; 236 reports/ thesis; 120 local print journals; 19 international journals/periodicals/magazines; 1,268 CD-ROMs; 135 audio-cassettes; 15 local magazines; 5,009 online foreign journals; 16 national newspapers, 6 pieces of large size rare maps. Library personnel are trying to strengthen its collections in Business Studies, Economics, Social Sciences, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, English, Computer Science and Engineering,

Electrical and Telecommunication Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Pharmacy and Social Science, etc.

Sections of Library

EWU Library has five sections to provide effective library services viz. Acquisition Section, Processing Section, Circulation Section, Reference Section, and Reserve section.

Key Features of IT Based Library System of EWU

- Web-based search of library materials;
- Book requisition received from the faculty through web;
- Checking of borrowing status;
- Web-based notice board;
- Book reservation request received from the faculty through web;
- Automated circulation system;
- Access to online journals;
- Six exclusive workstations (02 in each floor) for checking databases and searching online journals;
- Library materials processing job performed through library software;
- Generation of auto fine system for overdue library materials;
- Creation of various library reports by using library software.





E-Resources

EWU library provides access to several full texts eresources. Over 5,009 title online journals can be
searched directly through the internet. The Library is a
member of Bangladesh INASP-PERI consortium (BIPC)
and is equipped to access full-text articles, abstracts,
and bibliographical information of online journals of
different publishers in different disciplines. The Library
has also access to leading online journals like JSTOR
(Journal Storage), OUP (Oxford University Press).
Blackwell, Springer link, HINARI (Health Inter Network
Access to Research Initiative), and AGORA (Access to
Global Online Research in Agriculture), etc.

IT Facilities in Library

At present EWU library has 15 computers with equipped modern multimedia facilities which have been connected through LAN. To run the library smoothly, an officer of the Library supervises library software, online journals, consortium and network with the help of Information and Communication System (ICS) office. Electronic books are available in the Library in the form of CD-ROMs. A total of three printers (laser jet) are being used to meet the requirements of Library services.

Acquisition Services

Computer tools are used in carrying out acquisition services of the Library. In the meantime a good number of books were acquired in the Library to meet the demand of faculty members and students during Spring Semester 2008.

Processing Job

A database named EWULIBMIS has been utilized to process entire library materials. Bibliographic information is kept properly in the Library database for providing quick and instant services to the users of the University. At present, the Library has 6,103 records in the database.

Circulation System

In the EWU library every book and every user of the Library have been identified with a barcode reader. Two barcode readers are being used to issue and return library materials along with other computer facilities. The Library software is able to generate fine automatically for overdue library materials. During Spring Semester 2008, a large amount of books were borrowed by students.

IT based Searching and Retrieval

EWULIBMIS offers flexible search options to users through which users can search their desired information from any bibliographical record of Library database, such as author, title, subject, keyword, call number, Master File Number, accession number, etc.

Web-based Library Services

The Library has recently provided online information services for remote users. Users at long distance can easily get information regarding borrowing status, books' status, online journals, users' guide, online reservation facilities (for faculty members only), new arrival services, etc. through Internet.

The EWU Library remains closed on Saturdays, government holidays, and as per academic calendar of the University.

PARTICIPATION AT WORLDS UNIVERSITIES DEBATING CHAMPIONSHIP

East West University Debating team participated in the 28th Worlds Universities Debating Championships held in Thailand from 27 December 2007 to 5 January 2008. Assumption University of Thailand, Subornobhumi Campus, was the host institution. The preliminary rounds of debate were held at Assumption University campus, while the final rounds of debates were held at the Royal Ambassador Hotel of Pataiya Sea Resort. The EWU team comprised of three members. They are Mr. Kamrul Hassan, Moderator, Mr. Imteaz Khan, Moderator and Ms. Anika Rahman, President, EWUDC.



All three members of EWU team qualified as adjudicators. They judged all the nine rounds of preliminary debates as panel judges. One of the members, Anika Rahman, chaired a debate and this was the single instance of a Bangladeshi chairing a Worlds this year. We had two other independent members, who are our ex-students and national level debaters - Mr. Rashedul Hasan Stalin and Mr. Mohammad Saddam Hossain. They participated in the tournament as independent adjudicators. As a result, EWU had the largest number of 5 adjudicators judging at this level of a debating competition. Noother Bangladeshi teamhad this many adjudicators.

As a result of its participation, EWU earned the 146 position among the 400 institutions of the world that have participated in the last 5 Worlds championship. Only one Bangladeshi University, North South University has a higher ranking than us. We carried the flag of EWU and our name has become familiar among fraternities. We are recognized by the Worlds Debating Council and, as recognition of our contribution, one of our members Mr. Rashedul Hasan Stalin has been appointed the Deputy Chief Adjudicator (DCA) in the Asian Universities Debating Championship (AUDC) to be held in Malaysia this May.



INTRA UNIVERSITY DEBATING CHAMPIONSHIP

During the Spring semester, East West University Debating Club (EWUDC) organized an Intra University Debating Festival between 31 March and 2 April 2008. The objective was twofold. To find new debating talents and to prepare EWU debating teams for upcoming national and international competitions.

Second Mathematics Competition was held on April 8, 2008 and was organized by EWU Science Club. The following students secured the top ten places.


