Professor Ahmed Shafee is the New Vice Chancellor of EWU

Dr. Ahmed Shafee has been appointed Vice-Chancellor of East West University by the Honorable President of Bangladesh, who is the Chancellor of the University, on the recommendation of the Board of Trustees of the University.

Dr. Shafee had a very distinguished academic record, securing the top position in every public examination from Matriculation (East Pakistan) to MSc, with record marks at Notre Dame College and at the Physics Department of Dhaka University. He received the Award of the President of Pakistan for the best undergraduate student of East Pakistan and an Overseas Merit Scholarship for the

top science student of Dhaka University. He has a PhD degree from of the University of Cambridge for his research in theoretical particle physics. Dr Shafee completed postdoctoral fellowships at Abdus Salam International Center for Theoretical Physics, Italy (where he was a visiting scientist many times and also an Associate) and the University of Cambridge and later returned to Bangladesh to



join Dhaka University. Besides serving his term as Chairman of the Physics Department, he was the Founder-Director of the Institute of Information Technology of Dhaka University, and also acted as Dean of Science from time to time.

In addition to particle physics, Professor Shafee has worked on and guided research on various aspects of mathematical physics, including chaos, solitons, percolation, catastrophe theory, biophysics, atmospheric physics, astrophysics etc. His research papers have been published in some of the most well-known and respected journals in the USA, Holland, France and Italy, as well as in Bangladesh. He has worked on drug design at the Department of Molecular Biophysics of the University of Oxford and on medical imaging at the Medical Physics Department of Sheffield University. He was elected a Fellow of Bangladesh Physical Society and a Member of the Biophysical Society of the USA. He has given talks on physics and science education in many conferences.

Professor Shafee was the Convener of the Physics Section of the National School Syllabus Review Committee of the GoB, and also the Convener of the Review Committee of the Ministry of Science for research projects in physical sciences for many years.

Professor Shafee edited "The Physicist" - Journal of Bangladesh Physical Society - for more than a decade. He writes occasionally for newspapers, both print and web-based.

Seminar on "Road Safety" held at East West University

Rotaract Club of East West University arranged a seminar on "Road Safety" on 30 November at the auditorium of East West University.

EWU Digital Library

EWU digital library was launched on 27 July 2011. Syed Manzur Elahi, founder member, Board of Trustees, East West University, Chairman, Apex Group, and former Adviser to Caretaker Government of Bangladesh was present as the chief guest in this ceremony while Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, President, Board of Trustees of East West University, presided over the program. EWU Library is the first university library in Bangladesh that uses Greenstone Digital Library Software for building a digital library with a contribution to implement Bengali version of this software To maintain a world class standard, East West University Library has chosen this software to build a digital library for this university Greenstone Digital Library Software was successfully installed and implemented to serve the huge demand of digital information of the users as well as the intellectual community of the country. Primarily EWU Digital Library consists of News clippings, Theses and some other sample collections.



Collection

The general collection consists of approximately 24300 volumes, primarily scholarly monographs, related reference books, textbooks, pure reference materials, journals, magazines, and statistical publications, as well as current newspapers and periodicals. Collection of EWU Library is comprised of books and periodicals related to the field of Business Studies, Economics, Liberal Arts, Social Sciences. Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Physics, Pharmacy, Computer Science, Mathematics, English Language and Literature, and Bangladesh Studies.

Books are placed in open stacks for the convenience of use and consultation. EWU Library maintains open access shelves to give enough choices to users so that they can select desired library materials. Users can go directly to stacks and look for their required materials. 3rd Asian British Parliamentary Debate Competition- 2011 was organized by North South University, held since Dec 7 till Dec 11, 2011. A total 80 plus teams from 24 Asian nations participated in the contest. From Bangladesh, there were 14 universities and 30 debating teams; namely East West University, LCLS (London College of Legal Studies), North South University, IBA, Dhaka University, BRAC, BUET, IUB, IUT, UIU, Southeast University, Eastern University, Stamford University and Chittagong University.

On the criteria of overall points East West University ranked 2nd among the national teams. LCLS topped with 10 points, East West University 1 (Sanin and Hadee) followed the topper with 9 points. 4 other institutes tied with East West with the same 9 points are: NSU, BRAC, IUT, UIU and IUB. East West University 3 (Sabrina and Shofee) and IBA 1 jointly shared the third position with 8 points.



'EWUDC Spark' keeps sparking

'EWU Spark' (Sadi, Tanim and Tasnim) made a record by achieving 3 trophies in last Fall. They snatched Champion's trophy by defeating the home team, in October 2011 in the tournament organized by Government and Politics Department, Jahangirnagar University.
