Editorial

The events covered in this edition of the *EWU Newsletter* point clearly in one direction: we are on track! Or to put it slightly differently: we are sailing full steam ahead! Our lead stories, therefore, will tell you that we have just held our 8th convocation on 7 April and that the Foundation Stone laying ceremony of EWU following just the week later on 14 April. And there are other milestones that this newsletter is privileged to record: the first batch of Electrical and Electronics Engineering Graduates were able to attend this convocation and the English department has launched an MA in ELT program this semester.

And, of course, this edition of *EWU Newsletter* records the very full academic and cultural life of the university. In the following pages, therefore, we provide information about faculty and staff publications; we also note the many seminars and club events that made the campus a vibrant and stimulating place and all spring. What these pages will reveal then is a university growing in stature and confidence and consolidating its place as one of the premier private universities of the country and, indeed, the region!

EWU's 8th Convocation Held

East West University held its 8th convocation at Bangladesh China Friendship Conference Centre, Dhaka on 7 April 2009. About 3,000 people, including teachers, students, guardians and guests attended the ceremony. A total of 923 graduates from 15 programs received certificates in the convocation. Of them, 671 students were conferred undergraduate and 252 graduate degrees. Seven students were awarded gold medals for outstanding academic performance.

Honorable Education Minister Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid, MP presided over the Convocation ceremony and conferred the degrees. Professor Anisuzzaman, eminent educationist and litterateur, delivered the convocation speech.

After the guests took their seats at 10:30 a.m., the convocation started at 11:00 a.m. with ceremony and pageantry, much of it representing traditions that have been associated with convocations for centuries. After the convocation procession entered the Conference Hall, recitation from the Holy Qur'an followed. Mr. S I Nusrat A Chaudhury, Associate Professor, Department of Business Administration was the Convocation Marshal. He conducts the whole ceremony with aplomb.

As soon as the Honorable Education Minister declared the convocation ceremony open, Vice Chancellor Professor Mohammed Sharif delivered his address of welcome. He urged graduating students to contribute to the country's overall development by applying all that they had learnt at East West University.

In his speech, Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President, Board of Directors, said that the goal of East West University "is to make our students all-rounded individuals so that they can face the challenges of a highly competitive global economy and participate in nation-building activities."



In his convocation speech. Professor Anisuzzaman, Professor Emeritus, University of Dhaka, hailed East West University as "a distinguished institution of higher education in Bangladesh." He further added "although it is only in the thirteenth year of its existence" East West "has made a mark by imparting quality education and by refusing to treat education as a commodity for business." He maintains that although he is not against the expansion of higher education, he thinks "higher education is not for everyone and must be only for the deserving." He asked the university to "create new knowledge" instead of "transmitting received knowledge."



In his address the Honorable Education Minister asked East West University to ensure quality education among its students. Emphasizing the vital role private universities can play in educating Bangladeshis, the honorable minister called upon East West University to offer greater number of merit-based scholarships to deserving students. He also reminded graduating students that it is their responsibility to meet the new challenges of a rapidly globalizing world.

Ms. Naveen Ambareen gave the valedictory speech on behalf of the graduating class of 2009. She recounted the happy moments she had passed while at East West. She offered her heart-felt gratitude to the teachers of East West University for their generous help.

The convocation concluded after the Convocation Marshal gave the vote of thanks to all the people who had come to attend the 8th convocation of East West University and to everyone who had contributed to the success of the event. Finally, each participant was presented with a bag packet containing refreshments and the convocation memento.



Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony of EWU



The Honorable Finance Minister, Mr. Abul Maal Abdul Muhith, MP, laid the foundation stone of East West University's permanent campus on Tuesday, 14 April 2009 at 4.00 p.m. at Aftabnagar, Rampuar, Dhaka. Mr. Muhith appreciated East West University's role in ensuring quality higher education in the private sector.

Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President, Board of Directors of the university, gave the welcome address in the ceremony. "The presence of the Honorable Finance Minister shall remain as a source of inspiration to the university community as long as the university exits," said Mr. Ahmed. Professor Mohammed Sharif, Vice Chancellor, East West University gave the vote of thanks. Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Founder Director and Founder Vice Chancellor of the university, also spoke on the occasion. Dr. Farashuddin urged students to apply their acquired knowledge to develop the country. Founder members of the university, guests, faculty and staff members attended the ceremony.

The total construction area will be 7.4 bigha while the floor area 3,49,085 sq.ft; there will be also car parking facilities for 200 vehicles. All kinds of modern infrastructure facilities for quality higher education will be available in the permanent campus. The expected date of the completion of construction is June 2011.

EWU Condemns the Brutal BDR Incident

A special prayer and a human chain was organized at EWU Campus to condemn the brutal murder of valiant army officers and other innocent bystanders on 25 February 2009 in the BDR headquarters at Pilkhana.

Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, President, and other members of the Board of Directors, Dr. Mohammed Sharif, Vice Chancellor, Pro-VC, Deans, Chairpersons, Faculty members and a large number of EWU students participated in the human chain. The event began at 11:45 a.m. and ended at 12:25 p.m. in front of the EWU Administrative building. A minute of silence was observed by those present and this was followed by a special prayer for the departed souls.

Afterwards, a condolence book was opened where the President, Vice Chancellor, Pro-VC, faculty members, staff and EWU students wrote their comments. Mr. S I Nusrat A Chaudhury, Head of Career Counseling Center and the East West University Shangskritik Shongho, conducted the event.

The EWU Library: a Centre for Nurturing Excellence

Possessing a secure, controlled environment for the protection of its collections and the budget needed to acquire treasures, the East West University library offers its users a wide range of information and enquiry services with the help of state-of- the-art technologies. The Library's mission is to enable and enrich the teaching, learning and research endeavors of the University by delivering flexible access to relevant information resources and by providing quality services and facilities. To meet these needs the library provides access to an extensive range of information resources both electronically and in print. The vision of the EWU library is to provide the University's teaching and learning community with ample support to enable them to make a more direct contribution to the educational mission of EWU. The library remains open seven days in a week, something unique in all public and private universities of Bangladesh.

Accommodation: The Library can accommodate over 250 students at a time in its well-furnished reading rooms. On an average 2,000 students use it and 800 students carry out transactions per day. It is located on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floor of the Foundation Building and consist of approximately 11,000 square feet. Each floor is organized in terms of study space, special corners, stack areas, maps and journal area, photocopy corner, database search corner, library administration, processing section, procurement section, a user friendly newspaper display section, a large circulation desk, a convenient communication system, etc. In the ground floor there is a large pigeonhole area for keeping personal belongings that can accommodate about 450 bags at a time. There is also a "new arrivals" display board in the ground floor of the same building.

Arrangement of Library Materials: Books are arranged on the shelves subject-wise in numerical order and are classified according to the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) scheme so that items on the same or related subjects can be found together. The Sears list of Subject Headings (SSH) and Library of Congress Subject Headings (LCSH) are used to determine subjects Books that are catalogued according to the Anglo-American Cataloguing Rules 2nd Edition (AACR-2) and Bibliographical data is entered directly into the database using the library's own MIS.

Library Automation: The Library is completely automated and uses its own library management software. The software includes processing, circulation based on barcodes and search as well as other useful features. This Library web site (http://lib.ewubd.edu) is designed to provide online reservation, library collections search, rules and regulations of using library, user guide etc. Users can make bibliographies directly from the library catalogue. At the same time, users can check their own status regarding library materials borrowed and can take a printout of that record. Faculty members can place new library materials requisition available on the web site.

E-Resources: The library provides users the opportunity to access several full texts e-resources. Over 10,000 titled journal can be directly searched from the EWU computer network. The library is a member of the Bangladesh INASP-PERI Consortium (BIPC) for getting access to full text articles, abstracts, and bibliographical information of online journals of different publishers in different disciplines through Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS). Currently, the library provides access to 33 on line journal databases through the consortium. 
