মাননীয় প্রধান অতিথি, মাননীয় উপাচার্য, বোর্ড অব ডিরেক্টরসের প্রেসিডেন্ট, প্রো-উপাচার্য, শিক্ষকবৃন্দ, অতিথিবৃন্দ এবং ছাত্রছাত্রীরা, ইস্ট ওয়েস্ট বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের চতুর্দশ প্রতিষ্ঠা বার্ষিকীর এই আনন্দঘন অনুষ্ঠানে যোগ দিতে পেরে আমি আনন্দিত ও গর্বিত। বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়কে আমার আন্তরিক অভিনন্দন। এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের পরিচালকদের সম্পর্কে আমি জানি, তাঁদের বিদ্যানুরাণ ও কর্মদক্ষতায় বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের ক্রম সম্প্রসারণ ও উনুয়ন ঘটেছে। নতুন নতুন বিভাগ যুক্ত হয়েছে, শিক্ষকের সংখ্যা বৃদ্ধি পেয়েছে, বেড়েছে ছাত্রছাত্রীর সংখ্যাও। সেই সাথে সম্প্রসারিত হয়েছে এর অঙ্গন, ঘটেছে নতুন নতুন ভবন ও স্থানের সংযোজন। কিন্তু কেবল বহিরাঙ্গ নয়, বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় সমৃদ্ধ হয়েছে গভীরতার দিক থেকেও। আমি শিক্ষাণত গভীরতার কথাই বলছি।

এই গভীরতা দৃষ্টিভঙ্গির সঙ্গে জড়িত। আজকের অনুষ্ঠানে ছাত্রছাত্রীদেরকে আনুষ্ঠানিক শিক্ষা কর্মসূচীর বাইরের যে কার্যক্রম, যাকে সাংস্কৃতিক কার্যক্রম বলা যায়, তাতে কৃতিত্বের জন্য যে স্বীকৃতি দেওয়া হয়েছে এটা একটা দৃষ্টিভঙ্গির ব্যাপার। সেই সঙ্গে অটিস্টিক শিশুদের পরিচর্যায় নিয়োজিত SWID Bangladesh এর Ramna Branch কে যে আর্থিক সাহায়্য প্রদান করা হয়েছে তার ভেতরও এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের নিজন্ম দৃষ্টিভঙ্গি প্রতিফলিত। স্পষ্ট দেখতে পাচিছ যে ইস্ট ওয়েস্ট বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় সাংস্কৃতিক ও সামাজিক কাজকে গুরুত্ব দেয় এবং মূল্যবান বলে বিবেচনা করে।

যে কোন বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ই একটি শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠান তো বটেই, জ্ঞানের সৃষ্টি, আহরণ ও বিতরণই এর প্রথম দায়িত্ব ও কর্তব্যঃ কিন্তু সকল বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ই আবার সাংস্কৃতিক এবং চ্ছান্ত বিচারে সামাজিক প্রতিষ্ঠান বটে। মানুষ মাত্রই সামাজিক প্রাণী। তার বুদ্ধিবৃত্তি এবং সৃষ্টিশীলতা দুটোই সামাজিক ভাবে বিকশিত হয়। অন্য প্রাণী থেকে মানুষের ভিন্নতা এখানেই যে সে বুদ্ধিমান ও সৃষ্টিশীল, এবং এই ভিন্নতাই তাকে সামাজিক করে তোলে। সমাজ থেকে বিছিন্ন হতে চাইলেই যে আমরা বিছিন্ন হতে পারি তা নয়, সামাজিক অভ্যাস ও মূল্যবাধ আমাদের সঙ্গে সঙ্গেই থাকে, তার থেকে মুক্তি লাভ সম্ভব নয়।

কিন্তু মুক্তির কথা কেন বলছি? সমাজের ভেতর বাস করি বলেই তো আমরা বিকশিত ও সমৃদ্ধ হই। জ্ঞান, বুদ্ধি, মেধা, সৃষ্টিশীলতা সবকিছুই নির্ভর করে আদান প্রদানের ওপর। এই আদান প্রদানের মধ্য দিয়েই আমরা বড় একটা জগৎ পাই। কেবল সমসাময়িক থাকি না, চিরকালের ঐতিহ্যের সঙ্গে যুক্ত হয়ে পড়ি, কেবল স্থানে থাকি না, চলে যাই সমগ্র বিশ্বে। সমাজ তাই ওপু বন্ধনই নয়, সমাজ হচ্ছে বন্ধু ও অভিভাবকও। সমাজে কি ঘটছে সেদিকে তাই তাকাতে হয়। এবং বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় যদি সেদিকে না তাকায় তবে কে তাকাবে, কার আছে সে যোগ্যতা ও দৃষ্টিভঙ্গি, বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের যেমনটা আছে, যতটা আছে ?

প্রাইভেট বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়গুলোর ব্যাপারে নানা রকমের সমালোচনা রয়েছে। সেইসব সমালোচনার সবটাই যে অযথার্থ তা মোটেই নয়। কিন্তু সব বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় সমান মানের নয়, এটাও মানতে হবে। দেখা দরকার বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় কি করছে, কোন ধরনের মানুষ তৈরি করছে। একজন শিক্ষার্থী যখন পাশ করে বেরিয়ে যায় তখন তার মনে অবশ্যই প্রশু জাগে, জাগাটা খুবই স্বাভাবিক, যে সে কি পেল? কি পেয়েছে, কতটা পেয়েছে তার দ্বারা তার যোগ্যতা নিরূপিত হয়, কর্মজীবনে তার স্থান নির্দিষ্ট হয়ে যায়। কিন্তু মানুষ তো কেবল একজন উপার্জনক্ষম প্রাণী নয়, সে মানুষও: ওই যে বললাম সে সামাজিক প্রাণীও বটে। তাই যে প্রশুটা, কেবল আমি কি পেলাম তা নয়। মূল প্রশুটা হলো আমি কি হলাম, বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় আমার মনুষ্যত্কে কতটা বিকশিত করলো, কোন দষ্টিভঙ্গি আমার ভেতর সংক্রমিত করে দিল। এই যে কি হলাম এর পরীক্ষাটা হয় দেওয়ার ক্ষেত্রে। সমাজ থেকে নিচিছ, কিন্তু সমাজকে আমি কি দিচিছ সেটাও তো দেখতে হবে। সারা জীবনই কি আমি ঋণখেলাপী হয়ে থাকবো, নাকি শোধ করবো আমার ঋণ? কিন্তু ব্যাপারটা তো কেবল ঋণ পরিশোধের নয়। আসল ঘটনা নিজেকেই সমৃদ্ধ করা; কিন্তু সমাজকে সমৃদ্ধ না করতে পারলে তা আমার নিজের সমৃদ্ধি ঘটবে না।

পকরের পানি যদি ভালো না হয় তবে মাছ বাঁচে কি করে ? ভালো ভাবে বাঁচার জন্য কেবল বুদ্ধির নয়, হৃদয়েরও শিক্ষা চাই। শিক্ষা প্রতিষ্ঠানকে এই দায়িত্টা নিতে হয়। বিশেষ করে বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়কে। সেই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়কে তো কিছুতেই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় বলা যাবে না. যে কেবল বুদ্ধিকে শিক্ষিত করে, হৃদয়কে বাদ দিয়ে। এই যে সাংস্কৃতিক কাজ, সামাজিক দায়বদ্ধতা, এসবই হচ্ছে শিক্ষিত হৃদয়ের প্রমাণ। বুদ্ধি অবশ্যই সৃষ্টিশীল, কিন্তু বৃদ্ধি যদি হৃদয়ের প্রয়োজন না মেটায় তাহলে সে হয়ে পড়ে সংকীর্ণ, স্বার্থপর এবং এমনকি ধ্বংসাত্মক। যারা যুদ্ধ বাধায় তারা বৃদ্ধিমান, যারা সভ্যতাকে এগিয়ে নিয়ে যায় তারা একই সঙ্গে বৃদ্ধিমান ও হৃদয়বান। কেবল বৃদ্ধিতে কাজ হবার নয়। কেবল হৃদয়েও নয়। শিক্ষিত বুদ্ধি এবং শিক্ষিত হৃদয় দুটোই চাই। এই দুয়ের ভেতর সম্পর্কটা ওধু যে সহযোগিতারই হতে হবে তা নয়। দ্বান্দ্রিকও হওয়া দরকার বৈকি। বুদ্ধি হৃদয়কে পথ চলতে সাহায্য করবে, এবং হৃদয় বুদ্ধিকে করবে সংবেদনশীল ও দায়িত্পবণ। এই যে বুদ্ধি ও হদয়ের শিক্ষার একত্রযোগ এর প্রয়োজনেই তো আমাদের বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ে আসা। বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় তো বাজারের সেবক ও উৎপাদনের কারিগর তৈরি করে ন. সৃষ্টি করে পরিপূর্ণ মানুষ। অন্তত সৃষ্টি করতে চায় এবং যতটা করতে পারে ততটাই সার্থক হয়।

উন্তির কথাটা এসেছে। আসবেই। কিন্তু প্রশ্ন হল আমরা কোন ধরনের উন্নতি চাই? উন্নতিটা কি হবে খাড়াখাড়ি পাহাড়ের মতো? নাকি ভিন্ন ধরনের। পাহাড়ের সামাজিক ভূমিকা আছে বৈকি। সে মেঘকে থামিয়ে দিয়ে বৃষ্টিপাত ঘটায়। বরফ জমিয়ে ঝর্ণার সৃষ্টি করে। কিন্তু উন্নতি যদি পর্বতপ্রতিম হয় তাহলে তো ভীষণ বিপদ। পর্বত তো হৃদয়হীন, সে তো পাষাণে গড়া। চতুর্দিকে আজ যে উন্নতি দেখছি সেটা কিন্তু এই পাহাড়ের মতোই, কেত্র বিশেষ সে জগদ্দল পাহাড়ই। তাহলে উন্নতি কি হবে আকাশের মতো? না, তাও নয়। উন্নতি আকাশচারী হোক এটা চাইবো না।

তাকে থাকতে হবে ভূমিতেই। চাইবো কি যে উন্নতি নেমে আসুক বৃষ্টির মতো? না তাও নয়, কেননা বৃষ্টিপাত স্থায়ী নয় এবং অতিরিক্ত বৃষ্টিবেত প্লাবন হয়। না, আমরা বৃষ্টি নির্ভরতা চাইবো না, যেমন চাইবো প্লাবন। উন্নতি হওয়া দরকার নদীর মতো। নদীর মতোই সে সর্বত্রগামী হবে, হবে সৃষ্টিশীল, ভূমিকে উর্বর করবে, চলমানতা আনবে যানবাহনে। একদিকে হবে সে সমুদ্রমুখী, অন্যদিকে তার বিচরণ ঘটবে জনভূমিতে। ধারণ করবে পাহাড়ী বৃষ্টিপাত ও ঝর্ণাকে, পুষ্ট রাখবে খাল, বিল নালাকে। ভালো কথা, ওই যে সমুদ্র এবং খাল, বিল, নালা ওদেরকে যেন আমরা না ভূলি। সমুদ্রকে উপেক্ষা করে এখন আক্ষরিক অর্থেই আমরা সমুদ্রকে হারাচিছ, আবার জলধারা ও জলাশয়কে অবজ্ঞা করে তাদেরকে ওকিয়ে যেতে দিয়েছি। আমাদের সমুদ্র চলে যাচেছ অন্যের দখলে, জলাশয়ঙলো সামাজিক মালিকানা থেকে চ্যুত হয়ে পরিণত হচেছ ব্যক্তিগত সম্পতিতে।

সবকিছুকে ব্যক্তিগত করে তোলার পরিণতি যে কেমন ভয়াবহ হতে পারে আজকের পুঁজিবাদী বিশ্ব সেটা মর্মে মর্মে টের পাছে। অর্থনৈতিক ব্যবস্থায় সে এখন সামাজিক হস্তক্ষেপকে ডেকে নিয়ে আসছে। কিন্তু পুঁজিবাদী ব্যবস্থাটাতো বদলাছেনা, বহু মানুষের শ্রম ও সঞ্চয়ে সে অল্প মানুষের সেবা করছে। এই উন্নতিটা পাহাড়ের মতো, সমাজের বুকে বোঝার মতো চেপে বসে, আবার সে খরার মতোও বটে, নিশ্পেষিত করে মানুষের হৃদয়ানুভূতিকে, কেড়ে নেয় তার মনুষাত্ব, এবং অতিশয় স্বাস্থ্যবান মানুষেরাও পরিণত হয় নরকল্পালে। নির্দ্ধ কল্পল আমরা দেখতে পাই, স্থল স্বাস্থ্য ও উজ্জ্ব পোশাকে সজ্জিত কল্পালরা দৃশ্যমান হয় না- তফাণ্টাতো এটুকুরই মাত্র।

বাংলাদেশ প্রতিষ্ঠিত হয়েছে জয়ের মধ্য দিয়ে। কিন্তু আজ সর্বত্র দেখি হতাশা। এর কারণ প্রত্যেকে নিজের কথা ভাবে, সমাজের কথা না ভেবে। প্রত্যেকরই বৃদ্ধি তীক্ষ্ণ, কিন্তু হদয় সংকীর্ণ। এই মনোভাবের একটা কারণ পরাজিতের অনুভৃতি। যেন জয়ের পর আমরা হেরে গেছি। হেরে গেলাম কার কাছে? পরাজয়টা আসলে সেখানে ঘটেছে যেখানে আমরা জয়ী হয়েছিলাম। জয়ী হয়েছিলাম সমষ্টিগত চেতনার কারণে, পরাজিত হচ্ছি ওই চেতনা বিধ্বস্ত হয়ে যাবার দক্রন। প্রয়োজন ছিল আমাদের রাজনৈতিক বিজয়কে সামাজিক বিজয়ের দিকে এগিয়ে নিয়ে যাওয়া, সমাজে বৈপ্রবিক পরিবর্তন ঘটানো। সেই লক্ষ্য ভূলে আমরা ব্যক্তিগত হয়ে পড়লাম, আমাদের স্বপ্রগুলো ব্যক্তিগত উন্নতির দিকে আবর্তিত হতে থাকলো। বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের কাজ এই বৃত্তকে ভাঙ্গা, ব্যক্তিকে সামাজিক করে তোলা। ইস্ট ওয়েস্ট বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় সে দায়িত্ব সম্পর্কে সচেতন বলে জানি। সেই জন্যই ভরসা করি এই বিশ্ববিদ্যালয় আরো এগুবে। চতুর্দশ প্রতিষ্ঠা বার্ষিকীতে তাকে আবারো আন্তরিক অভিনন্দন।

The 2nd prize winners from EWU category were Audri Rana, Tanha Binte Abid and Mahin from B, and the 3rd prize winners from Group A, and B were Eeman Syed Huda and Syeda Madeha Mowla respectively.

Department of English Holds 3rd International Conference on "Empire and English Studies: Pedagogy and Activism Now"



The English Department of East West University, organized a two-day conference on 11 December 2009. This was the 3rd international conference held by the university. The conference titled 'Empire and English Studies: Pedagogy and Activism Now' received an overwhelming response from eminent scholars. The conference saw a congregation of scholars from the different of the world. The Vice Chancellor, Dr. Md. Sharif, the President of Board of Directors, Jalaluddin Ahmed, UGC Chair Professor Nazrul Islam graced the inaugural session of the conference. The conference was brightened up when Dr. Serajul Islam Choudhury, Professor Emeritus of the University of Dhaka, stepped in. The conveners of the conference were Zahid Akter and Hasanal Zayed of the English Department.

The conference began with a warm-hearted welcoming speech by Farhana Farid, a faculty member. Afterwards, plenary speeches were delivered, highlighting issues relating to empire, colonialism, post-colonialism, education and the English language: Dr. Harish K. Trivedi, Professor, Delhi University focused on 'A Postcolonial Trajectory: English Studies in India 1947-2007'; Dr. Kaisar Haq, Professor of Dhaka University, on 'Nirad C.Choudhuri, CBE (Hony) and the Twilight of Empire Now'; Dr. Fakrul Alam on 'Confronting Empire'; Dr. Z.N. Patil, professor of The English and Foreign Languages University of Hyderabad discussed 'Multilingualism and Key Issues in Postcolonial English Language Pedagogy: A Plenary'; Dr. Niyogi De, University of California at Los Angeles 'Postcolonial Education and Empire of Media: A Feminist Argument for Interdisciplinary Studies'.

The plenary sessions were followed by tea breaks where the ice cubes of empire, pedagogy, colonialism, postcolonialism and the English language continued among the participants. The issue of imperialism was everywhere in the air on the day.

Dr. Shamshad Mortuza presented a paper on 'English Studies: A Master-Slave Discourse' where he employed Lacanian psychoanalytic theory in order to analyze the English departments as a site for the Master-Slave discourse.

Dr. Smita Sinha, from Berhampur University, presented a paper on 'Linguistic Chauvinism in India – English vs. Regional Languages' focusing on quantitative research with an aim to classifying various issues relating to the existence of linguistic chauvinism in India. Debasish Lahiri noted in his presentation on 'Writing Back and Forth: Incontinent Ordinance in "Oriental" Jones' that imperialism did not end with the British in India, and that imperialism's instabilities and illusions are always evident, if we care to look, in the language it uses to describe itself.

Dr. V. Lakshmanan, from Annamalai University, presented a paper on 'Maori Predicament in Hone Kouke's Waiora' highlighting on "assimilation" of the Maori culture into the dominant culture.

Mohammad Jahangir Alam, a graduate student of IER, Dhaka University, presented a paper on 'The Political Economy of EFL in Bangladesh: Present Extent and Future Implications' and to delve into the extent of permanence and prevalence of English in Bangladesh's post-colonial, post-independence society.

Sharmin Sultana, from United International University, in her paper 'Language as a Means of Perpetuation of Men-Women Power Hierarchy: Illustrating from English Texts Used in Bangladesh', talked about the challenges relating to language in order to reshape existing gender relations in society. A joint presentation on 'ESL Materials and Cultural Imperialism: A Case Study of Bangladesh' by F.S. Pamela Islam, from East West University, and Dr. Waliul Islam, from Dhaka University, emphasized how English apparently shifted from its imperial status, with its base in Britain, to an international language repositioning itself through its divergence in different parts of this globalized world, but has continued spreading its cultural hues. He also noted how English cultural elements are infiltrating silently into Bangladeshi culture through ESL materials used here. The first day concluded with a "Creative Writing" session where distinguished writers including Niaz Zaman and Kaiser Huq, read from their works.

Second Day of Conference: After Professor Z. N. Patil's presentation in the plenary session, Ishrat Jahan, from East West University presented 'Reading Fanon and Wright Today: Violence, Master-Slave Dichotomy, and the Negro Question' stressing the process through which a Black person understands that it is not he/she, who makes meaning for his/herself, but meaning itself that was always there, pre-existing.

Kathryn Hummel, a Ph.D student from South Australia, explored the tension between post-imperial/postcolonial versus gender identification in the context of her experience as an Australian researcher attempting to represent the work and life stories of Bangladeshi women in a paper titled 'Can Bidesi-apa Build a Bridge? Poco, Gender and the Longing to Belong'.

- iii. Browsing facilities: Users may search/browse library online journals and the EWU online catalogue through six PCs (two PCs at each floor) in the library.
- iv. Newspaper facilities: The library subscribes to 16 national leading dailies (9 Bengali and 7 English). Users may also access back issues of newspapers up to last two months.
- v. Online access facilities: East West University Library is a member of the INASP-PERI Consortium (BIPC) for getting access to full-text articles, abstracts, and bibliographical information of online journals of different publishers on different disciplines through the Bangladesh Academy of Sciences (BAS).

Corporate Membership: EWU Library has corporate membership with British Council Library, Dhaka, and American Information Centre (Archer K. Blood American Center Library). With these memberships EWU library users may avail browsing, searching Online Public Access Catalogue, photocopy services, and access to online journal of those institutions.

IFLA Membership

EWU library became a member of the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA) on 11 November 2008. EWU Library will benefit from this arrangement by getting or sharing specialized expertise on various types of libraries and library workshops, receiving

selective newsletters and facilities to exchange electronic information of IFLA documents, including IFLA journal (a widely used information source), IFLA Directory, IFLA Annual Report etc. EWU Library will also get the opportunity to participate in the IFLA general conference with a discount registration fee.
