Finance Adviser urges industrialists to invest in education, research

Dr Salehuddin Ahmed urges investment in Education and Research to address Skilled Manpower gap

Dr Salehuddin Ahmed, Adviser, Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Science and Technology, Bangladesh, urged industrialists to invest in 'Education and Research' to bridge the gap in skilled manpower and knowledge in the industrial sector.

He made these remarks as the Chief Guest at the celebration ceremony of the Graduate Diploma in Leather, Leather Goods and Footwear Management program of East West University (EWU) held at the EWU campus in Aftab Nagar on Sunday.
